MATSU SITUATION STUDY
(Supplement #1 to GP/I-76, dtd April 1, 1955)

This memorandum is a supplement to GP/I-76, dated 1 April 1955, which was submitted in reply to a request by OGI for information on military installations in the Matsu area as determined by a study of the latest available photography.

For convenience in reporting the existing situation and the periodic changes, the Matsu area is arbitrarily divided into two sections, ~~the~~ Fochow and the Pehling Peninsula. The dividing line is 26°18' N. lat.

Photographic coverage received since the last report has been spotty, but still has provided coverage for portions of the Foochow area previously not covered, especially the urban section north of the Min Hsiang (River). Also, coverage was obtained of the northern portion of the Fehling Peninsula. Since this is the first coverage of some areas, many new positions are being reported. This should not be interpreted to

indicate that all these positions have been installed since [REDACTED]

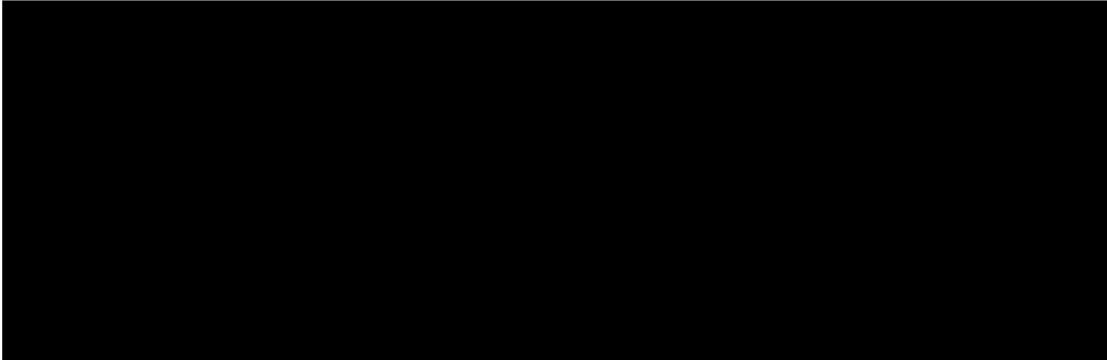
