HAZE A

COMMENT: An amphibious version of the MI-8/HIP C helicopter has been designated the MI-14, HAZE A. The HAZE A has a boat hull, sponsons along the side of the fuselage near the aft section, and retractable landing gear. This helicopter is used in ASW and sea search/rescue operations.

NOTE: The sponsons should not be confused with the air conditioning/fuel tanks along the fuselage of the HIP C. The sponsons are located farther aft and protrude farther.
