TRANSSHIPPING SHED, 3 JIB CRANES, OPEN STORAGE,
AND AN EIGHT TANK POL STORAGE AREA. TENT AREAS
ARE OBSERVED IN THE NORTHEAST AREA OF THE PORT
AND IN THE VICINITY OF THE OLD CIVIL AIRFIELD.
A LARGE UNIDENTIFIED BUILDING IS NOTED ON THE
WEST SIDE OF THE ROAD TO AL HUDAYDAH AND JUST
SOUTH OF THE PORT. A DE/PF, 2 POSSIBLE PC, 2
