- In The question has been raised as to whether payment of transfer allowances may be made to more than one member of a family when both husbend /and wife are staff employees. The question was presented to the Office of General Counsel by the Countroller for legal opinion.
 - 2. This office has received General Counsel opinion QC/B-7523a, dated 27 June 1957, addressed to the Comptroller relating to the above subject which states in part as follows:

"The basic authority for home transfer allowance is permissive and is not payment to which an employee is entitled as a matter of right-The province that it shall be paid to "eligible" starr personnel provided in paragraph 4 a. and puragraph 3 b. requires that all applicable eligibility criteria be not. By definition, paragraph 2 a. reads that the allerances are granted to an employee for "extraordizary and necessary expenses decised invident to the establishment of his residence at a PCS post ... Limitations have then been set on the amounts which can be paid to a single employee. an exployes with one member of a family and an amployee with more than one namber of a family.

5. In the present case, the employee-bushand claimed the maximum enount on the basis of two mamiers of the family. It would appear to be quite contrary to the spirit of the Regulation to give that same foundly payments in excess of this unximum amount incause of the fact that the wife too was an employee since the fact of her employment adds mathing to the extraordiscry or more seary expenses incidental to the establishment of the husband's post. Under these circumstances the Wife does not meet the eligibility criteria as an employee and is not entitled to the allowance."
