SUBJECT: Immunization

DATE: 25 July 1951

1. Individuals selected for Disaster Planning should be immunized. Immunization should consist of the following:

- Smallpox
- Typhoid and Paratyphoid
- Tetanus

2. It is medically desirable that immunization ante-date the required activation of the plan. However, any formalized procedure might well direct unnecessary attention to Plan participants.

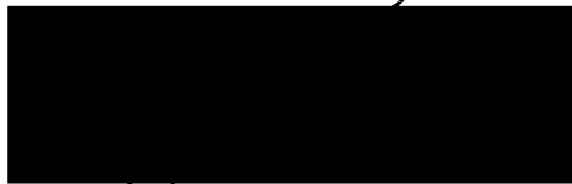
3. The Medical Office is of the opinion that the Security aspects of the Plan outweigh the immunization requirements. Therefore, it is recommended that group immunization be accomplished only if the Plan is activated and that necessary procedures be performed at [redacted]

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4. Immunizations of selectees subject to overseas assignment can easily be accomplished by having attention directed to [redacted] This matter should be coordinated with Technical Services and [redacted]'s office.
