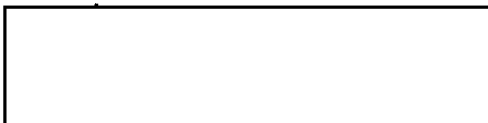
SUBJECT : Assumption of Office
