MAY 17-19: KIEV - FLY TO BAKU ON MAY 19;  
MAY 19-20: BAKU - FLY TO TASHKENT NIGHT OF MAY 20;  
MAY 21-22: TASHKENT - FLY TO SAMARKAND MAY 23;  
MAY 23-24: SAMARKAND - FLY TO MOSCOW MORNING OF MAY 24;

MAY 24-26: MOSCOW - DEPART THE USSR MAY 26.
