During the past year the Office of the Geographer has greatly benefitted from the services of the Geographical Area in your organization. At this time we wish to express our appreciation of the fine cooperation received and to call special attention to four projects which have been unusually helpful in our work.

1. The production of a series of Consular District maps will render much more facile our records and control of the geographical description of these Foreign Service post areas. [redacted] and his staff are responsible for this most excellent cartographic project.

2. The compilation of an inventory of first and second order administration divisions for all the countries of the world. The result is of high value to many bureaus, both geographically and geographically, throughout the government. [redacted] editorial staff carried out the project.
