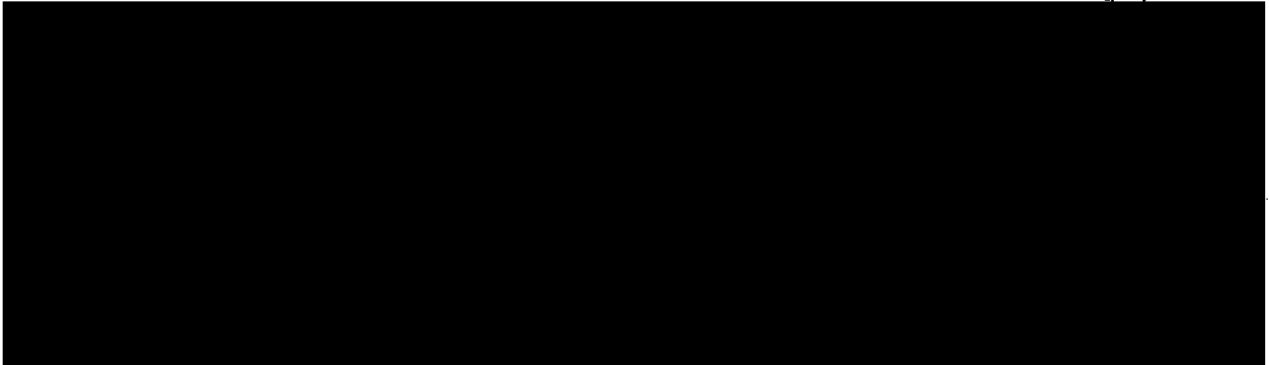




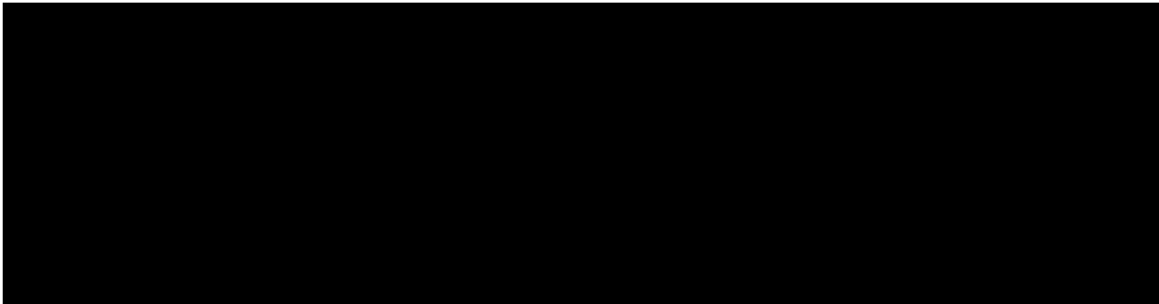

6. Received from Col. Porter of Air Force a memorandum relating to an incident in which State apparently had sent a cable to its Swiss Embassy on the basis of an SO report - to which the Air Force had given a relatively low evaluation -- without including the Air Force evaluation. Porter expressed the view that such disseminations should be checked with the agency of primary interest before dissemination. After some consideration, I am of the tentative view that this may well be a good ideal for finished intelligence, but is wholly impracticable in the dissemination of intelligence information, particularly to intelligence agencies. I have requested  to investigate the facts of this particular incident and to give me a written report thereon. After reviewing this, I shall probably prepare a memorandum for the record or for the Director's log expressing my views, and give a copy to Air Force. 25X1A9a

place, [REDACTED] had recommended against CIA representation on the Security sub-Committee and had insisted that he should be a general adviser to the Chief of the American Delegation.

I understood that [REDACTED] had made this clear to Layton and obtained his agreement thereon. Furthermore, it was clearly understood by us that the CIA representative would be covert vis-a-vis third parties, since it was made a condition that he appear in military uniform. Consequently, Layton's request for official CIA positions at this conference was entirely out of order. In the future, our [REDACTED]
