SUBJECT: Procurement of State Department
Personnel for the Central Reports Staff

REFERENCE: Memorandum for Admiral Souers, 15 April
1946, "Personnel Requisitions for the
Central Reports Staff", Tab "E"

1. The additional contribution of professional personnel desired of the Department of State for the Central Reports Staff consists of one person qualified to serve as chief of a regional branch and five others qualified to serve as political and/or economic analysts.

2. The Director of the Foreign Service has undertaken informally to provide for C.R.S. two Foreign Service officers, one qualified to serve as branch chief and one as political analyst. Formal action toward their assignment through SA-MC will be initiated at a later date.

3. It is desired to recruit the remaining State Department personnel from O.R.I. so far as practicable. In that connection, the following O.R.I. personnel have been informally recommended to me for consideration:
