1. Col. Bicknell gave a review of the meeting of the Joint Topographical Subcommittee of 29 May 1944, which related particularly to Quickies.

25X1A9a 2. [redacted] and Lt. Quam were instructed as to the procedure to be taken on second phase studies on Ryukyus, Bonins and Kuriles, which are to be prepared in lieu of JANIS publications on these areas.

3. Lt. Quam was also given a memorandum on a first phase study on the Falkland Islands, which is to be submitted within four days.

4. A proposed letter of promulgation for JANIS publications was discussed and if signature approval is obtained from the four Chiefs of the Intelligences Agencies represented, such letter will be adopted.

5. Col. Dubois, assisted by [redacted] and Lt. Quam, is charged with the responsibility of preparing a study on the problem relating to the Board on Geographical Names. He will undertake to make a study of this situation with the view of presenting such study to the J.T.S. and later to the J.I.C.
