Acquisition of ChiCom Geological Maps

the Map Library Division has acquired color-photo copies of five ChiCom geological maps - the most significant acquisition to date. Four sheets (1:1,000,000) extend southward from the China-USSR border in N.W. Manchuria and one (1:200,000) covers an area in central Shantung Province. The topographic base maps were compiled in 1958 and the geological information in 1960-62. The maps are based on the 1954 Peking Datum, and the geodetic control indicates a possible tie to the Soviet system.

Copies of the five maps have been made available to the Intelligence Community and a detailed analysis of the geodetic potential is being undertaken.
