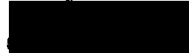

F O R E W O R D

At the end of the fiscal year the Office of Research and Reports, CIA (ORR), surveyed its support to the economic defense program. It is believed that the resulting report may be of interest to the economic defense community and it is therefore being circulated to members of the EDAC Executive Committee.

This report is an attempt to tabulate the intelligence supplied by ORR in direct support of the Economic Defense Community during the fiscal year 1955. In general this support falls into four principal categories: intelligence contributions and review assignments; commodity intelligence; enforcement intelligence; and, direct intelligence support to overseas representatives.

The intelligence support listed and summarized herein actually represents a minimum of ORR support. No attempt has been made to assess the value of either the informal day-to-day support and coordination rendered by ORR analysts or the numerous research studies which, while of basic importance to the economic defense community, are not focussed directly on economic defense problems.
