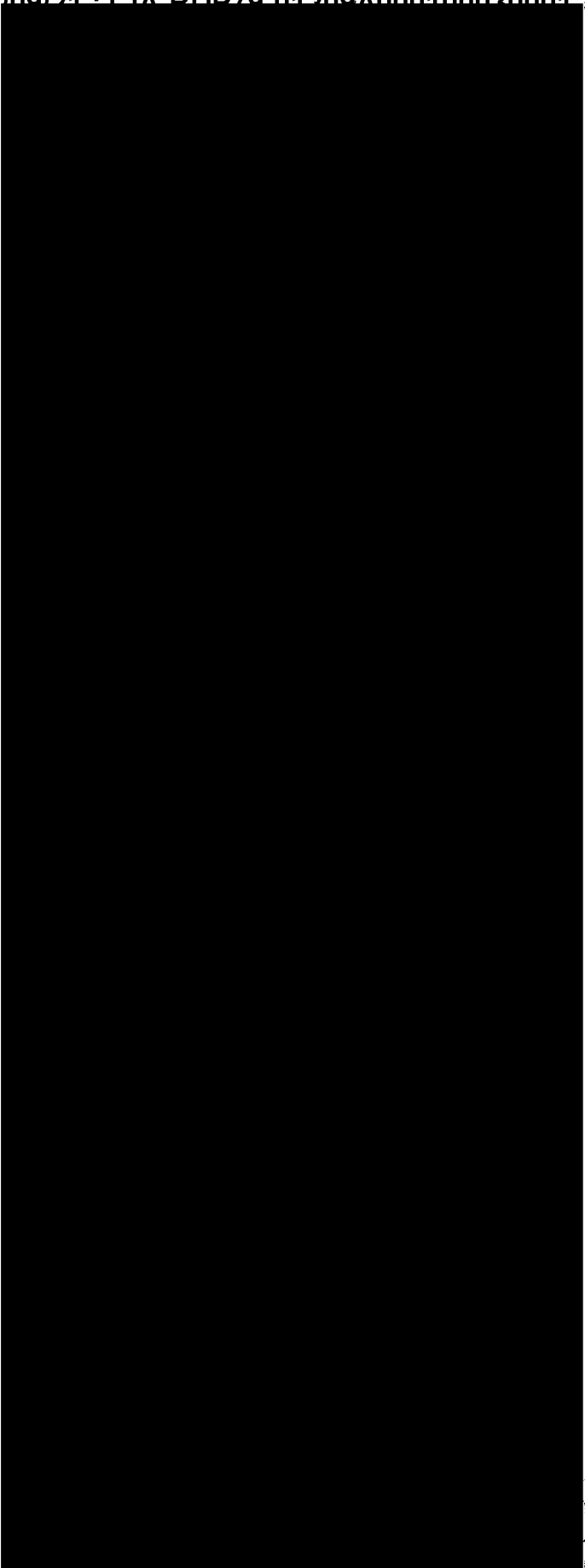

1 January 1973	Beirut Airport, Lebanon	Security men arrested a traveler armed with a pistol and two grenades. The traveler, a Saudi, had a ticket showing Ethiopia as his final destination. (UNCLASSIFIED)
2 January 1973	Munro Province, Buenos Aires, Argentina	Six presumed terrorists took over a Minimax Supermarket and set fire to the building and its contents. According to one press report, the Revolutionary Army of the People was probably responsible. (Comment: A probable motive for choosing the Supermarket as a target may be the financial backing by the Rockefeller interests. Minimax Supermarkets were the targets of extremist fire bombings prior to the 1969 visit to Argentina by the Rockefeller Mission.) (UNCLASSIFIED)

The caller, allegedly a member of Basque Fatherland and Liberty (ETA), reported that a pressure-sensitive, barometric bomb was on the plane, and that it was set to detonate at 3,000 feet. The caller was reported to have demanded \$200,000 to reveal where on the aircraft he had planted the bomb. The aircraft landed without incident, and a thorough search by the Air

A bomb explosion destroyed the offices of the Jewish Agency in Paris and wrecked eleven cars parked in the street. Police believe the bomb was placed outside the door of the offices, which are on the ground floor. No one was injured in the blast, which occurred before the office opened. (Comment: The Agency arranges for the emigration of Jews to Israel. The offices of the Franco-Israeli Alliance are also in the same building. The Black September Organization claimed credit for the incident.) (UNCLASSIFIED)

Letter Bomb Summary

Letter Bombs in Morocco

A press communique from the Moroccan National Union of Popular Forces (UNFP), an opposition party, reported that UNFP leader Mohamed el-Yazghi was seriously injured in Rabat on 13 January 1973 by a letter bomb explosion. A second letter bomb, addressed to UNFP leader Omar Benjelloun, was dismantled before it exploded. The police immediately began an investigation of what are the first letter bomb incidents in Morocco.  
(UNCLASSIFIED)

Letter Bombs in Israel

Three letter bombs mailed in Israel were discovered in different parts of the country on 14 January 1973. One was found in a Tel Aviv post office, addressed in Hebrew to a man in Tiberias; one in a Beersheba post office, addressed to a man there and a third to a woman in Kiryat Gat. The Kiryat Gat bomb exploded, slightly injuring three persons. These bombs are the first to have been mailed from within Israel to Israelis. (UNCLASSIFIED)

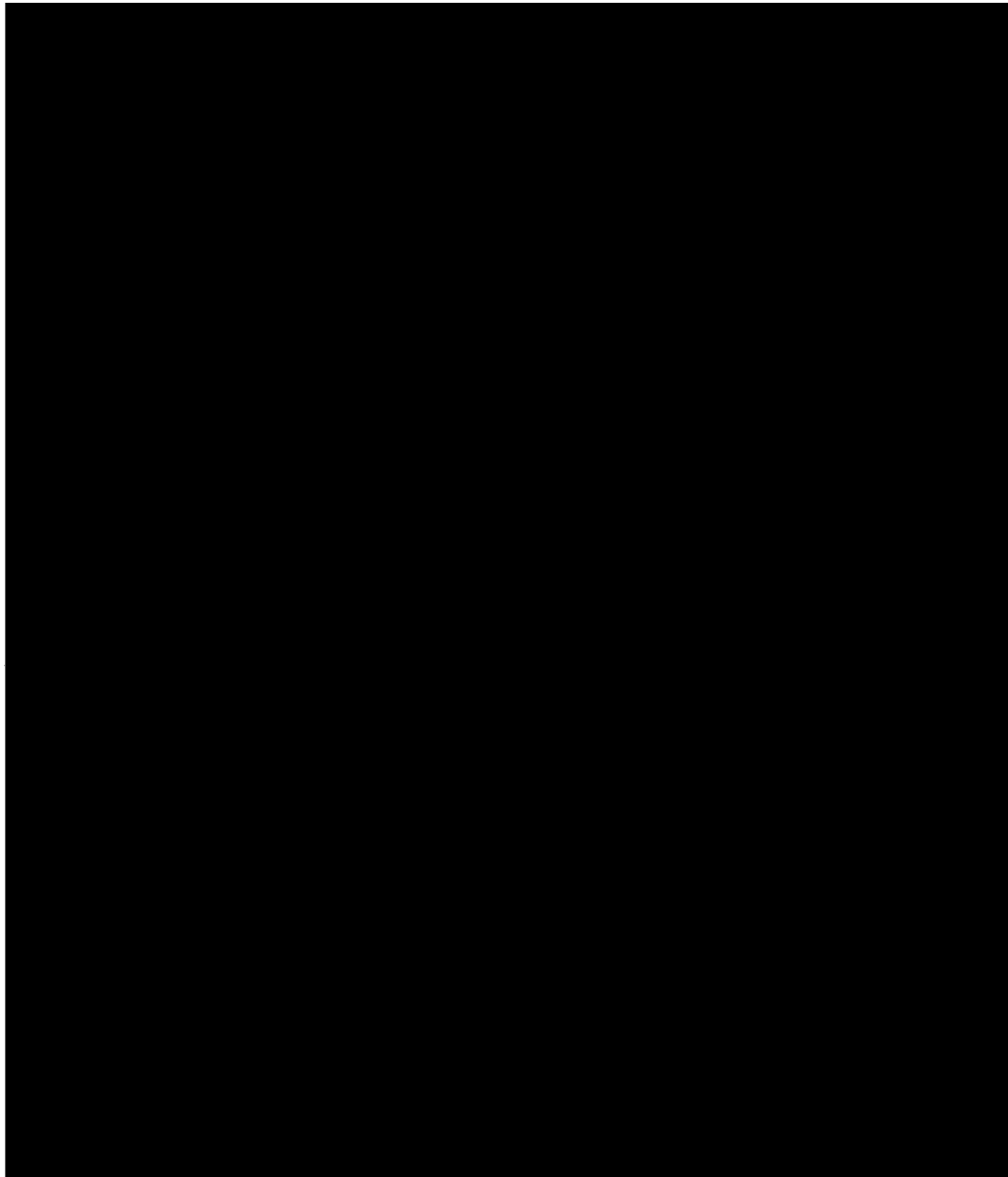

Theft of Weapons in Denmark

The Danish press reported the theft of a small quantity of arms and ammunition from a local home-guard depot during the Christmas holidays, when no guards were posted. The stolen items included six automatic weapons, two semi-automatic rifles and 550 rounds of ammunition.

The type of weapons stolen and the fact that radio equipment, which could easily be sold on the local market, and a quantity of cash were left behind, lead Danish authorities to believe that the theft was by foreign terrorists and/or that the weapons were distributed to political extremists for possible terrorist activity in Denmark.

The theft is still under investigation, although the fact that it was not discovered until 10 January 1973 makes follow-up difficult. (UNCLASSIFIED)

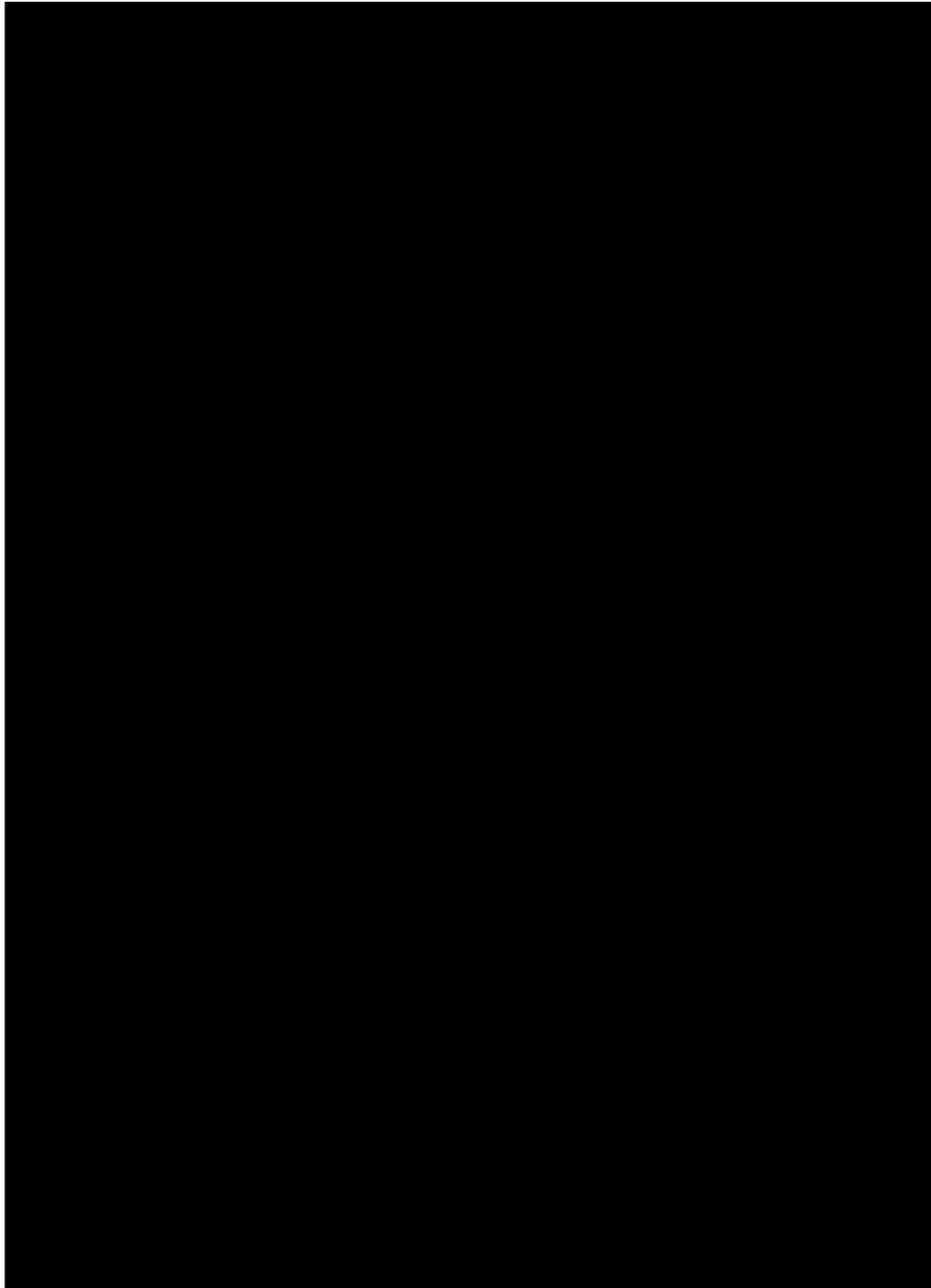

Police reported that the letter, postmarked Athens and addressed to a prominent Montreal rabbi, was successfully dismantled before it could explode. The rabbi, S.M.
