A Government-furnished Richards GFL-940 MCE Elevating Light Table was delivered to the contractor during this period.

During this visit the following points were covered:

1. Delivery of the table will be on schedule -- approximately 22 November 1965.
2. A 12° collimation is required for reproduction of 200 LP/MM.
3. Processed vycor glass will be used in place of the quartz glass over the U.V. light source. This glass has an 85% transmittance in the U.V. wavelength region.
4. requested that we supply film and spools for testing; film resolution targets will also be furnished.
5. The general light source will have a maximum illumination of 1500 ft-lamb, and will vary to 15% of this value.
6. Upon review of the design, the system appears satisfactory.

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A positive method of preventing any ammonia escaping is incorporated.

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
