NOTE: IDEALIST SCOPE SAINT VII [REDACTED] scheduled for 12 October was overtaken by events, as on 7 October 1973 an operational deployment "FORWARD PASS" was ordered [REDACTED] for possible coverage of the Middle East crisis. The U-2R aircraft has been in position since 8 October 1973. The aircraft is prepared to respond to approved requests to conduct high altitude [REDACTED] missions on selected Middle East targets. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] FORWARD PASS missions to the Middle East may be requested in November.

25X1 GA-013		mission confirmed the presence of a Soviet F class submarine and a KANIN class destroyer in Mariel harbor. A large pedestal mounted parabolic antenna (about 40.5 feet in diameter) was seen at the Tapaste Comsat ground station, located about ten miles southeast of Havana which will provide additional communications links between Cuba and the USSR. The mission aborted 1 1/2 hours early because a power interruption at Guantanamo Naval Station prevented positive radar flight following of the U-2.	
		2. The October mission was tasked to ascertain if military offensive weapons were being emplaced in the vicinity of the Guantanamo Naval Station. Readout of mission photography disclosed that 12 drive-through revetments and nine artillery revetments have been constructed near Guantanamo since the OLYMPIC FIRE mission [Redacted]	25X1
		3. As of 12 October the USIB requirement for 90% of Cuba to be photographed quarterly showed [Redacted] of the area covered. By 1 December, if no missions are flown during November, the quarterly requirement will stand at [Redacted]	25X1
