25X1 1. [redacted] LIAISON Talked with George Pickett, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, and told him we had been unable to locate the calendar which he inadvertently left during a meeting with Office of Data Processing officials. Pickett had later phoned the office and asked them to send it to me but my name was misunderstood. Also, Pickett gave the wrong room number. I told Pickett we are continuing to check for it.

25X1 2. [redacted] LIAISON Jean Evans and Ed Levine, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, were at Headquarters and reviewed Agency documents related to the [redacted] case. [redacted] O/SA/DO/O, met with Evans and Levine.

25X1 3. [redacted] BRIEFING Accompanied Jean Evans, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, to a meeting with [redacted] C/CI Staff, regarding a letter from former Agency employee [redacted] to the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence. The Select Committee may want to inquire into the incidents [redacted] relates and Evans wanted our opinions on the best way to proceed. Evans views this as a particularly sensitive area. [redacted] and I recommended that the Committee inquiries on this subject be made personally from Chairman Daniel K. Inouye (D., Hawaii) to the Director.

25X1 4. [redacted] LIAISON Met with Kenneth de Graffenreid, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, who said he had been asked by the Committee to "put to bed" charges made by the father of an American [redacted] who was killed in Chile in about 1972. Apparently, [redacted] father is charging CIA was somehow involved. [redacted]

25X1 5. ([redacted] LIAISON Called Elliot Maxwell, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, and told him [redacted] SA-D/DCI/IC, would meet with him at 3:00 p.m. on 11 October to review graphics material which Maxwell might want to borrow. This was agreeable.
