Suggested Changes to 11 September Draft of SB-51: The Significance  
of the New Indonesian Government

Paragraph 2. Revise to read:

We believe that the cabinet will proceed cautiously with a moderate program that, for the most part, follows closely programs previously supported by more conservative elements in Parliament. ~~The cabinet~~ <sup>will</sup> avoid the adoption of radical policies that might cause ~~moderate elements of the present government to withdraw their support and cause the fall of the government.~~

(Also in Paragraph 15 substitute above for present wording in first 2 sentences and add "moreover" to 3rd sentence.)

Paragraph 3. a. line 5, add: "...opposition, which has already crystallized to a certain extent, to solidify, etc...."

Paragraph 9. Last sentence, strike "unexpectedly" and change final clause to read: "..., to cause the government to fall"
