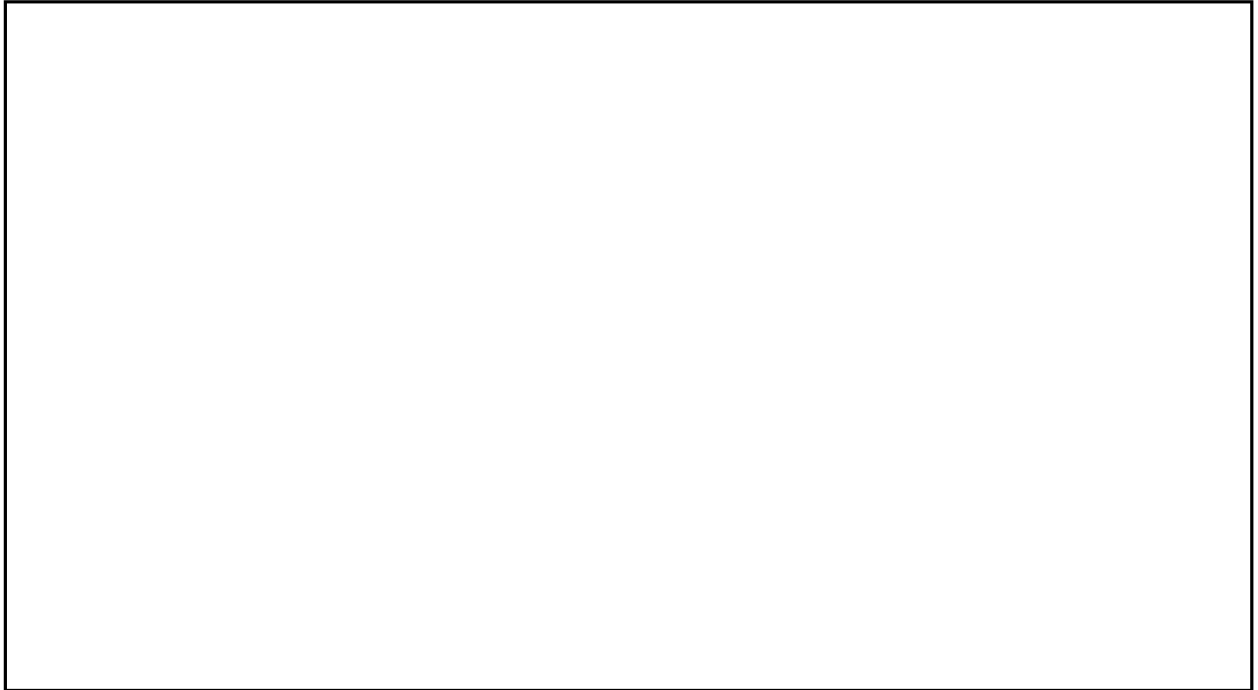

Soviet Forces in Cuba

- I. Soviet military components remaining in Cuba number close to 17,000 officers and men.

- B. The remainder--something over 3,000 men--consists of headquarters, communications, and training personnel.

- II. Recent activities of these forces have been aimed at improving the defenses of Cuba.

- A. SAM units are being moved into better positions for defending important areas, particularly military airfields.
