INTELLIGENCE MEMORANDUM

The Situation in Indonesia (Information as of 4:00 PM EST)

- 1. There have been no major developments reported since the last situation report.
- 2. Despite General Suharto's seeming slowness in asserting his newly-won authority, he apparently remains the defacto national executive and is continuing to issue public orders on "behalf" of Sukarno.
- 3. Suharto's latest orders have called upon regional and local authorities to maintain calm, ensure the smooth movement of consumer goods, maintain vigilance against the "Nekolim project of Malaysia" and "make devotion to the people a starting point."
- 4. A mass rally in support of General Suharto staged by the army's student and political allies is scheduled for Djakarta on Tuesday.
