\*Turkey: Last night's abortive coup by former Colonel Aydemir and officers from the Turkish Military Academy in Ankara underscores again the basic instability existing in Turkey and increases the likelihood of tighter military control. Prime Minister Inonu's recent allegation that a critical political situation had developed may even have prompted Aydemir to launch his coup attempt in the hope of exploiting the apparent confusion and uncertainty within the government.

This was Aydemir's second attempt within fifteen months to overthrow the military-supported Inonu regime. Like its predecessor in February 1962, this coup attempt collapsed within a few hours when it failed to attract any significant military support. As former commander of the Military Academy, Aydemir had strong support among the student officers and apparently also had some armored support.

Aydemir believed he had widespread support throughout the army

During the six hours between midnight, when the coup attempt was launched, and dawn, when it apparently collapsed, the radio stations in Ankara and Istanbul were briefly occupied by Aydemir supporters and the rebels succeeded in occupying positions in government buildings in the center of Ankara. The final outcome, however, was certain once the major military units pledged loyalty to the government and the air force issued its ultimatum to give up or be bombed.
