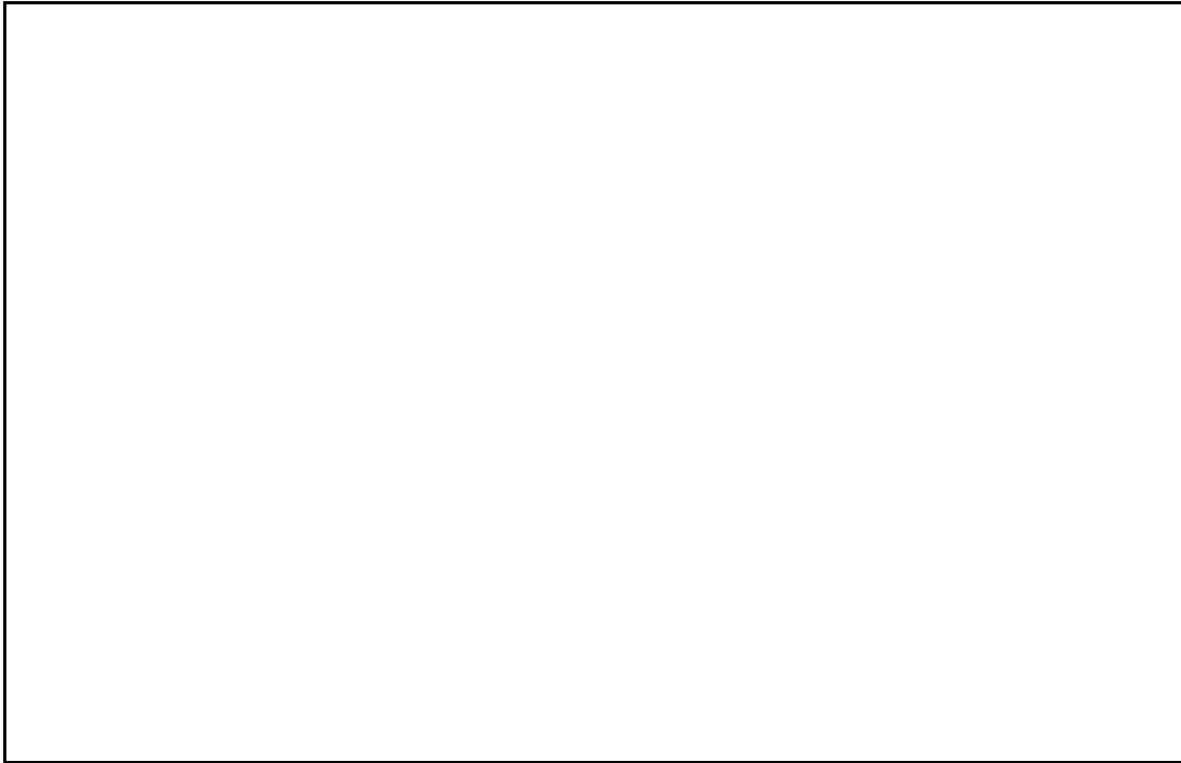

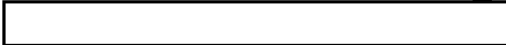

CANADA - COMMUNIST CHINA: REPRESENTATIVES OF OTTAWA AND PEKING RESUMED RECOGNITION TALKS IN STOCKHOLM ON 1 AUGUST, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] THE CHINESE INITIATED THE MEETING, THE FIRST SINCE LAST MARCH. A CANADIAN OFFICIAL CHARACTERIZED THE SESSION AS "CONSTRUCTIVE," AND INDICATED THAT SIGNIFICANT PROGRESS WAS ACHIEVED. OTTAWA NOW HOPES TO AVOID RESPONDING TO THE CHINESE CLAIMS TO SOVEREIGNTY OVER TAIWAN IN ANY FORMAL COMMUNIQUÉ. THE CANADIANS PREFER TO SUBSTITUTE AN ORAL STATEMENT IN PARLIAMENT ON THEIR POSITION. 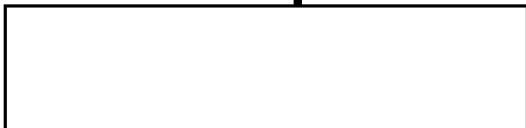
