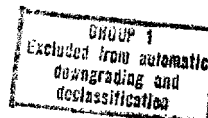

2. (S/NFD) After careful review, this Agency believes that disclosure of report CIA/RR 65-28 (SECRET) [REDACTED] would be inimical to the interests of the U. S. as outlined in paragraph 3 below. Approval of the authority requested in paragraph 3 of the referenced letter, therefore, cannot be granted.

3. (S/NFD) Significant source information, as stated in the report in question, is over four months old. Since the report pertains to a dynamic political and military environment, the picture it presents in terms of today is questionable until current analysis either modifies, confirms or disproves the previous CIA research.
