### IMAGERY INFORMATION REPORT

#### POLISH AMPHIBIOUS TRAINING EXERCISE AT UTSKA NAVAL TRAINING CENTER (S)

(S/WNINTEL) A Polish amphibious training exercise with major elements of a sea landing regiment, elements of an engineer battalion, and four Polnocny medium landing ships (LSMs) was observed at Utska Naval Training Center, Poland, on imagery of [redacted] (Figure 1, not all illustrated).

(S/WNINTEL) Two companies of the sea landing regiment, two PT-76 tanks, and an engineer battalion were on the beach. Two additional companies of the sea landing regiment and the remainder of the PT-76 tank company were 500 meters behind the beach. Major items of equipment included at least 22 OT-62 armored personnel carriers, 13 probable PT-76 tanks, nine PTS amphibious transporters, four K-61 amphibious transporters, and numerous cargo and van trucks. Four Polnocny LSMs were dispersed offshore.

(TSR) The Polish sea landing regiment at Gdansk Army Barracks Husaren 001 was out of garrison when seen on [redacted] (Figure 2). The regiment had returned to garrison by [redacted]. The sea landing division engineer battalion at Leborg Army Barracks 001 [redacted] was probably out of garrison when observed on [redacted] imagery of [redacted].
