1. On 29 May 1953 four merchant vessels were observed at Swedish Quay loading coal. One was identified as the Italian SS Citta Di Savona, 7155 GT. The others were two French vessels of between 4000 and 5000 deadweight tons and a Danish vessel of the same approximate tonnage.
2. The 6021 GT Polish motor vessel Warszawa was observed alongside Polish Quay at Cukroportu shed.
3. Six small minesweepers were observed alongside fingerpiers in military basin #2.
4. A small military transport, described as between 250-300 feet in length, was observed outside of military basin #2.
5. Submarines [Redacted] were seen in basin #10.
6. A 50 to 60 foot motorboat equipped with 6 depth charges in racks (3 on each side) was observed near the fingerpiers of military basin #2.
