Although derogatory remarks about the German Youth Administration (GYA) in the U.S. Zone have not been found among available Leipzig broadcasts monitored by FBIIB, on 23 July 1947, the USSR-controlled Berlin radio broadcasts the following item relative to the subject of German youth in the U.S. Zone:

"The renewed dissolution of the Munich Youth Parliament by the USMG is commented upon by the BERLINER ZEITUNG. "The renewed prohibition proves that a school of democracy cannot be organized like a game. In the Soviet Zone thousands of young members of works councils and delegations in parish, district, and State Parliaments were learning the fundamental elements of democracy through their day-to-day practical work. Equality of youth is not a game but a fact." (IN GERMAN TO GERMAN)
