Wilversum Radio, broadcasting in the Netherlands Home Service on 14 February 1950 at 1700 GMT, announced the following:

"The Netherlands are ready to adopt the new wavelengths provisionally agreed to at the Copenhagen Conference on 15 March. Provided that there are no objections raised by any other country the program of Hilversum I will be broadcast on the frequency of 746 kcs., 402 meters and Hilversum II will use a frequency of 1007 kcs., 293 meters. The subsidiary transmitters Hengelo, "Oogeveen and Palsbergen will use a frequency of 1594 kcs., 189 meters."
