1. From the beginning of June 1953 on, there were only Soviet Air Force units in Pápa. The Soviets occupied the castle and two houses on Fő tér, as well as the big barracks at the airfield.

2. No more YAK planes were visible. Planes observed were 82 MIG-15s and 31 IL-10s, as well as courier planes. Four four-engined planes were seen but their type was not positively identified.
