- 5. Twice a week examinations on political training are given, in order to evaluate the political proparation of the men. The men are forced to attend the political courses and they have no interast in listening to the discussions and lectures. Recently, even the political officers show weariness and boredom in their tasks, as they face the total indifference of the soldiers and officers.
- 6. Only three to five percent of the men (members of the Communist Party) attend the courses and the seminars, but even these do so just to make a good name in the Party or for the purpose of being promoted or to receive a good job at the end of their military service.
- 7. The political officers, realizing the catastrophic results of the tests given at the end of the seminars or at the periodical yearly exams, give fake ratings to the men in order to hide their (the officers!) failure to win over the masses to the Party line. It should be noted that the inspecting officers sent by the High Political Office of the army establish a tacit agreement with the unit's officers to hide the situation and to avoid complications. The political officers do this in order to avoid being fixed as incompetent.
