1. Klotsche Airfield, near Dresden-- There were 43 aircraft stationed at the airfield on 3 Feb 54. Twelve of them were two-jet machines which are often seen in flight over Dresden. They appear to be fighters. Most of the other planes at the field are MIG 15 jet fighters. There are also 8 planes which greatly resemble the American DC 3; these planes make regular flights towards Czechoslovakia.
2. Rechlin Airfield-- There are about 64 jet fighters and six standard engined aircraft at the Rechlin Airfield at the present time. The number of the latter kind varies from time to time because of frequent arrivals and departures. They are mostly two-engined planes, painted dark gray, and appear to be engaged in transport work because cases and equipment are frequently unloaded. The jet fighters are mainly MIG 15s. The runway at the field has been extended in the direction of Löbsen. The newly erected hangars are also in the neighborhood of Löbsen.
