1. In early Feb 1954 there arrived at Stepanovan, 68 "automobile hospitals"; at Baralet, 52 of the same. At Baralet there also arrived 8 operating automobiles, with modern equipment for surgical operations. Stepanovan is northeast of Leninskhan. Baralet is presumably identical with Baraleti (41°32' N--43°30' E).
2. The various army corps in this general area are now expecting the arrival of additional ambulances and surgical automobiles.
