The airfield is located about 16 kilometers from Dnistrov at a point north of Orud'yovo. [redacted] the approximate location of the airfield. In 1942 it was only a cleared, circular area about four miles in diameter in a wooded region. [redacted] the length of the tightly packed, earth runway. The airfield had been cleared and leveled during World War II. [redacted]

the airfield would be developed to the fullest. [] two engine bombers on the field, a group of MIG's and heavy bombers of the PD-6 and PD-7 types the runway could accommodate aircraft of this class.

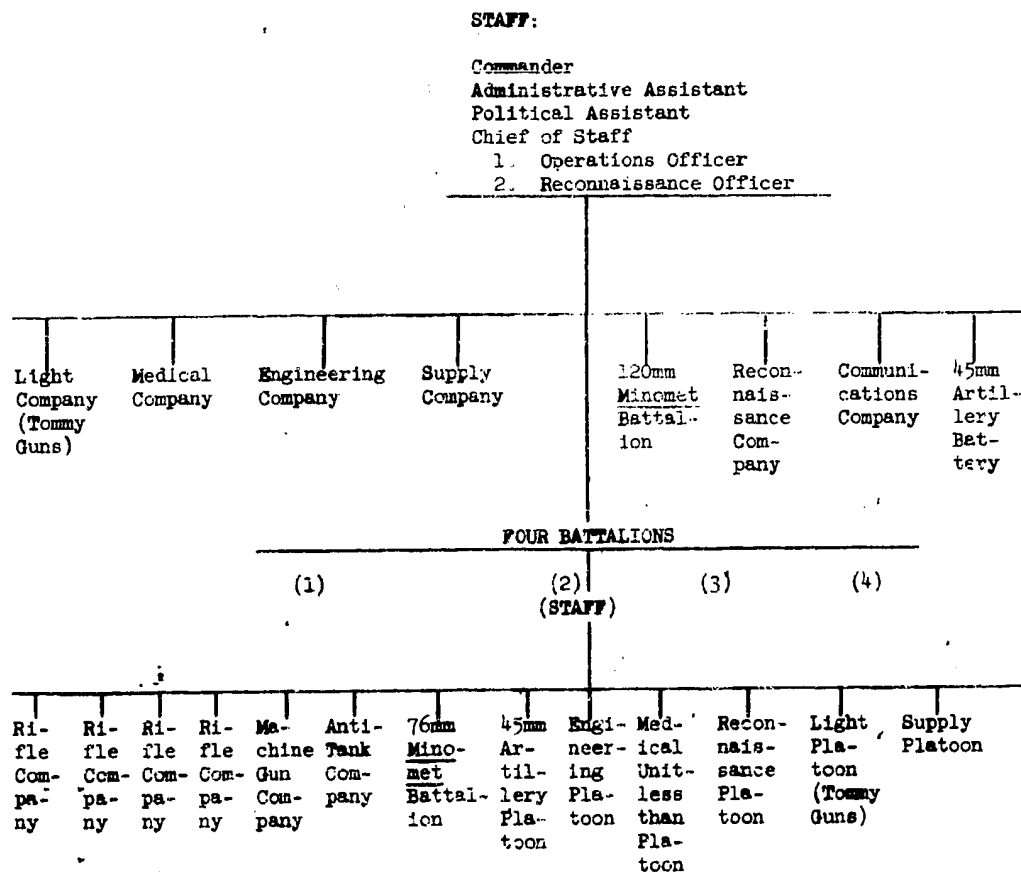

Each Rifle Platoon was divided into four units of 10 to 12 men each.

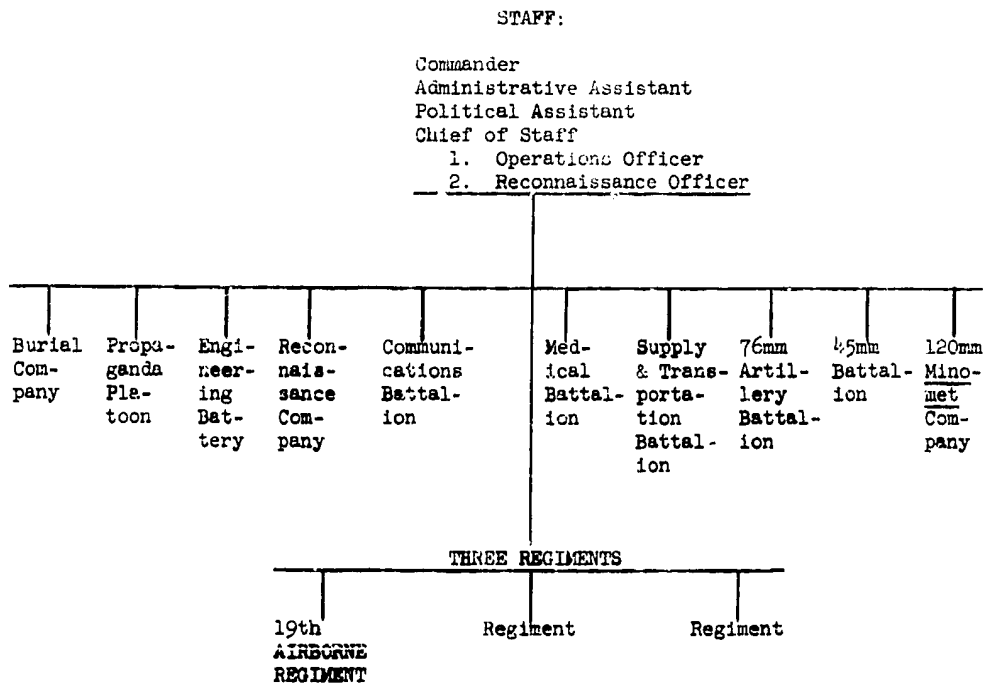

The following chart represents the organizational structure of the Tenth Airborne Division:



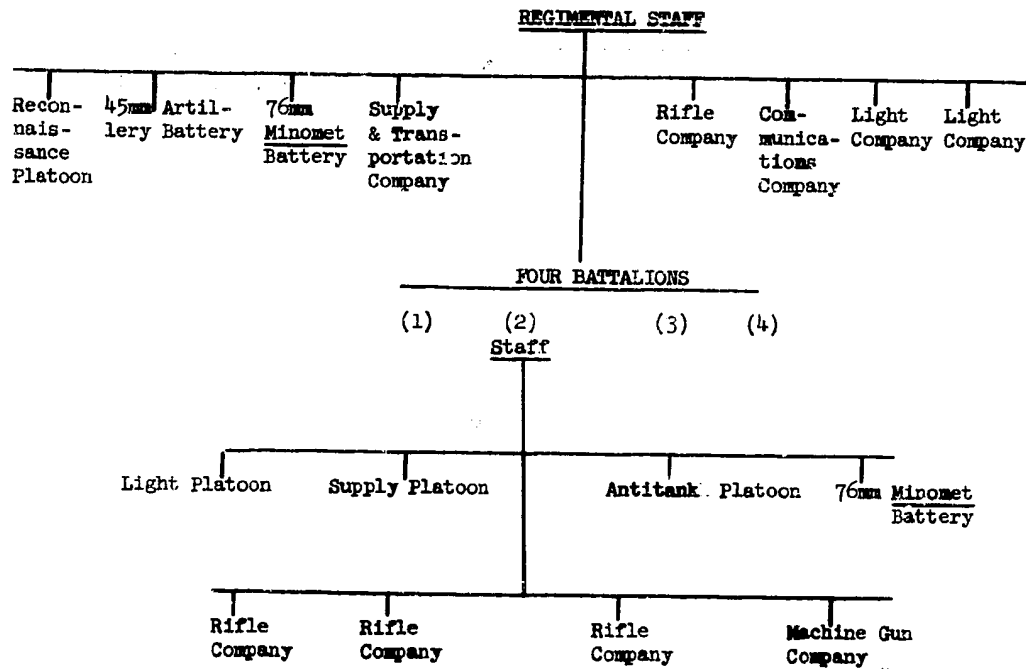

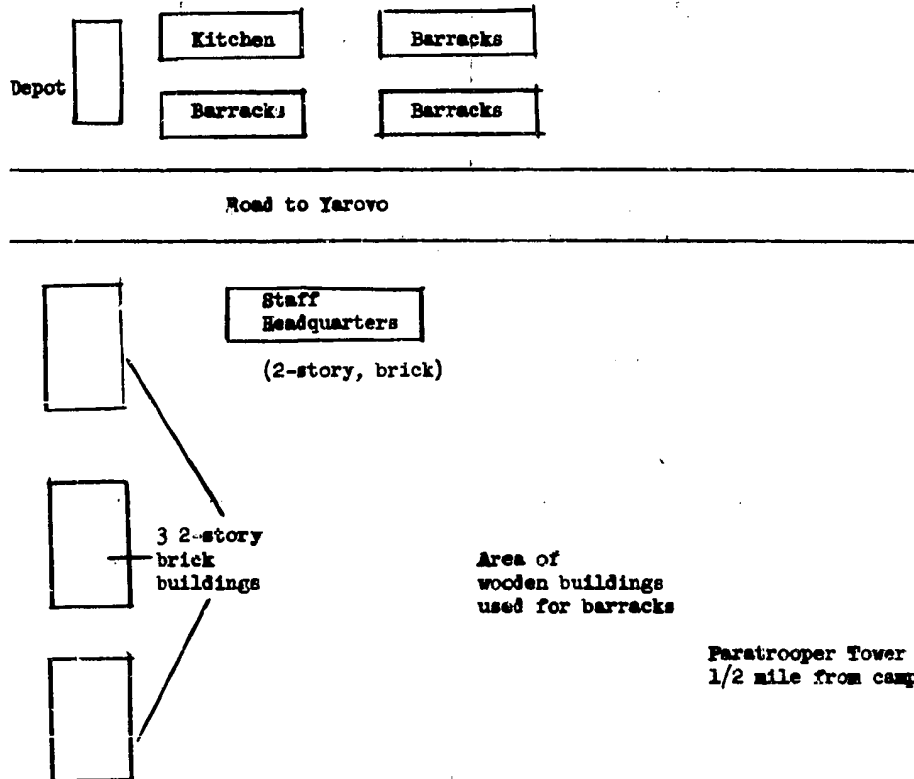
