GDR ORGANIZATION OF MATERIAL PLANNING FOR 1953

Comment: The following report, which presents information on the organization of material planning in the GDR (German Democratic Republic) for 1953, is the full text of [redacted] an original East German pamphlet published [date not indicated] by the Main Department for Material Planning in the State Administration for Material Supply of the GDR Government. The pamphlet, entitled "Organization of Material Planning for 1953," and subtitled "Index of Claimant Agencies," is marked "For Official Use Only" (equivalent to "Restricted") and carries the further notation "Status as of May 1952." It consists of a list of GDR agencies authorized to receive allocations of materials, showing the distribution channels for various types of materials and various categories of users.

An introduction and additional notations included in the list itself spell out in some detail the general fields of responsibility in the matter of allocation of materials, and exceptions to the general rules.

Some of the German terms used in specifying the distribution channels have no exact English equivalents. The following are the principal terms of this type which are used in this document:

"Kontingentraeger" -- literally "one who carries (primary responsibility for) an allocation," i.e., an agency which is the primary recipient of an allocation. In this report, the term "claimant agency" has been used to designate such agencies.

"Plantraeger" -- literally "one who carries (primary responsibility for) a plan," i.e., an agency which has been made responsible for certain assignments under the Economic Plan, such assignments to be carried out by subordinate units. The term "plan recipient" has been used in this report to designate such agencies.

"Bedarfstraeger" -- literally "one who carries a requirement," i.e., an agency or enterprise which receives allocations of materials according to its own needs (in contrast to the "Kontingentstraeger," which receives allocations in accordance with the requirements of other agencies for which it serves as the distribution channel). Although the coined word "allocatee" and the term "allocation recipient" have sometimes been used to designate "Bedarfstraeger," in this report the term "authorized consumer" has been chosen as possibly more descriptive. In some cases, a "Bedarfstraegergruppe," or "group of authorized consumers," is interpolated in the distribution system as an intermediary between the claimant agency and the authorized consumer.

"Staatssekretariat mit eigenem Geschäftsbereich," -- literally, "state secretariat with own field of operations"; in this report, the term "state secretariat with portfolio" has been used.

INTRODUCTION

This index of claimant agencies forms a part of the planning operations for the 1953 Economic Plan, Plan Section for Material Supply. The index must be followed in setting up the plan for material requirements.

The more important plan recipients under the Economic Plan receive from the State Administration for Material Supply allocations of materials for carrying out their assigned tasks under the Plan, and are thus claimant agencies. This index of claimant agencies specifies the exceptions, i.e., cases where the planning of material requirements and the allocation of materials are not handled by the plan recipient.

This index specifies the affiliations of the authorized consumers and groups of authorized consumers with the claimant agencies (ministries, state secretariats with portfolio in the GDR government, and HA Material Supply of the Land governments), with regard both to the planning of material requirements and to the allocation of materials. Changes in the affiliations of the claimant agencies require the approval of the HA Material Planning of the State Administration for Material Supply.

This index is not applicable to supplying the economy with products listed under "power industry" and "food and beverage industry" plan groups. These plan groups are subject to the regulations of the State Secretariat for Coal and Power, HV (Main Administration for) Power, and of the Ministry of Trade and Supply.

The 1953 plan year will be governed by the principles set forth as follows:

1. The ordering agency (Auftraggeber) will make materials available as follows:

a. For work let on contract (Lohnbearbeitung), such as boring, stamping, milling, tempering, etc., the actual materials, or material allocations, will be made available by the ordering agency. Contract work by other industries (including the printing industry) for the paper or cardboard-processing industry will be permissible only for second-stage processing, for example, the printing and stapling of cardboard boxes for the processing or cardboard-box enterprises. Pulp paper and cardboard may be used by industries other than the paper and cardboard-processing industry only as general expense items or for carrying out planned production.

In the case of orders for nonstandard parts and accessories for industrial products, such as ships' superstructures, parts for boiler assemblies, supports for lathes, structural elements for bridge cranes, etc., the actual materials and accessories or allocations for such materials and accessories must be made available by the ordering agency. Material for steel constructions (plan item 40 00 000) required for and used in building projects will be planned by the claimant agency "Ministry of Reconstruction." The plants commissioned with the production of steel constructions will receive material allocations from the quota of the Ministry of Reconstruction via the building enterprise from which the order originates. (Such transactions do not involve the Ministry of Transportation.) The material requirements for the production of the above-mentioned types of steel constructions by building enterprises operated for and by the Directorates General of the Reichsbahn and of Water Transport will be planned by the claimant agency "Ministry of Transportation."

b. Assembly work, whether part of a building project or separate installation of equipment, will be classed as a production service for which the ordering agency must make available either the actual materials and accessories or allocations therefor. (This ruling does not refer to assembly work under the plan group for electrical engineering, plan item 51 92 000; see below.)

2. a. The claimant agencies for the centrally administered industries, for the centrally administered transportation system, for the postal and telecommunications system, and for agriculture and forestry will be responsible for the planning and allocation of all materials required by the authorized consumers and groups of authorized consumers subordinate to them (exceptions under sections 4 - 10).

b. Industrial training schools, trade schools, schools of engineering and of technology, etc., apprentice shops in factories, apprentice homes, vocational schools in plants, recreation and vacation homes, industrial vacation camps, boarding schools, fire-protection and inspection services (exclusive of plant protective force A), repair shops such as shoe-repair shops, laundries, tailoring shops, etc., and amateur theatrical groups, as well as other social, sports, and cultural organizations and institutions sponsored by factories will be supplied with all necessary materials by their respective enterprises via the proper claimant agencies (exceptions under sections 4 - 10).

c. All materials required by the central headquarters, branches, and distribution centers of the DEZs (Deutsche Handelszentralen, German Trade Centers) which are subordinate to the claimant agencies for the centrally directed industries will be supplied by said claimant agencies (exceptions under sections 4 - 10).

3. The Land governments, HA Material Supply, and the Magistrat of Greater Berlin (hereinafter referred to as Land governments) will be responsible for the total requirements of the people-owned local industries, and of all hand trades (exceptions under sections 4 - 10). The Land governments, moreover, will be responsible for the planning and allocation of material for all nonindustrial authorized consumers who, according to this index, are not supplied by any other claimant agency. The Land governments are also responsible for the planning and allocation of materials which come under the heading of investment projects, general expenses, etc., of the production and trade enterprises of the following DEZs Motor Fuels and Mineral Oils, Scrap and Waste Materials, Industrial Supplies, and Pharmaceuticals and Hospital Supplies. Only the central offices of these DEZs will receive all their supplies through the ZVO.

4. The total requirements of the public health system (including the industrial public health system) for medical equipment and supplies and pharmaceuticals will be planned for all claimant agencies by the plan recipient.

namely, the Ministry of Public Health. This ministry will receive and distribute all allocations, with the exception of such veterinary pharmaceuticals, veterinary instruments, and veterinary equipment and installations as are the exclusive concern of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry.

5. Requirements of protective work clothing, protective agents for the safety of workers, (not including safety equipment), oxygen apparatus, equipment for protection against gas, and publicity media dealing with industrial safety will be planned by the plan recipient, namely, the Ministry of Labor, which, as claimant agency, will also allocate and distribute such materials. Types of protective work clothing, etc., are depicted in the illustrated catalog of safety devices and measures for the protection of workers issued by DEZ Industrial Textiles.

6. a. All sports and hiking equipment required by the claimant agencies will be planned, allocated, and distributed by the Ministry of Trade and Supply. This category includes all non-built-in sports equipment, sports clothing, clothing for the FDJ (Free German Youth) and Young Pioneers, bikers' supplies and equipment, and FDJ requirements of musical instruments and special sports apparatus, such as racing motorcycles and bicycles, special tires for racing vehicles, replacement parts, etc.

b. All materials required by sports training schools and FDJ schools which are under the direct administration of the DS (Deutscher Sportausschuss, German Sports Committee), or of the Central Council of the FDJ, respectively, and by all other FDJ and sports institutions, will be supplied by the various Land governments (exceptions under sections 4 - 6a and 7 - 10).

7. The supply of solid fuels and firewood is subject to the following regulations:

The responsibility for the supply of solid fuels as set forth in this index covers both the planning and allocation of supplies. All authorized consumers under the centrally administered industries, the centrally administered transportation system, the centrally administered building trades, and the claimant agency "ZVO" will be issued their allocations of solid fuels and firewood, including solid fuels and firewood for the production of gas by the gas works under Land administration, via their respective claimant agencies.

Solid fuels and firewood for consumption by the population in general will be planned by and allocated to the plan recipient, namely, the Ministry of Trade and Supply, for distribution.

All other authorized consumers will be supplied from the allocations of the Land governments (for example, local enterprises; authorized consumers under the Ministries of Agriculture and Forestry and Postal Affairs and Telecommunications; enterprises of the Trade Organizations; institutions of public health and education; control and procurement agencies, etc.)

8. The supply of liquid motor fuels and tires (including both casings and inner tubes) will be subject to the following regulations:

The assignment of responsibility for the various fields of utilization, as set forth in this index of claimant agencies, is binding for both the planning and the allocation of these materials.

The Stadtkreise and Landkreise will be responsible for supplying the enterprises of the centrally administered industries (not including SAGs) with liquid fuels for stationary installations, for transportation of goods (truck transportation, transportation within plants), and for administrative

transportation (passenger cars, motorcycles). Diesel fuel and motor oil required for power production in installations operated by HV Power are not included in the foregoing. The Stadtkreise and Landkreise will also be responsible for the supply of tires and tubes, with the exception of such tires and tubes as are used in the production process, e.g., in the production of trucks, passenger cars, motorcycles, trailers, mobile equipment, etc.

The Directorate General for Motor Transport (GD Kraftverkehr) -- not including the portion of the Directorate General which is concerned with Highways -- will plan and receive the necessary motor fuel, tires, and tubes to carry out the motor-transport plan of the centrally administered industries.

The Directorates General for the Reichsbahn and for Water Transport, and the claimant agencies "Ministry of Postal Affairs and Telecommunications," "SAG," and "ZVO" will receive the total allocations of liquid fuels, tires, and tubes for the fulfillment of their planned quotas.

The claimant agency "Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry" will plan and supply all liquid fuels and tires required for agricultural, forestry, and horticultural production, in addition to all motor fuel and tires for MAS (Machine-Lending Stations), VEG (People-Owned Agricultural Enterprises), the Working Cooperative of Agronomic Institutions, state-owned forestry enterprises, and the people-owned inland fishing enterprises and fish hatcheries, including motor fuel and tires for the MAS in connection with industrial transportation, for example, transportation of timber from forests to processing or shipping points.

The Land governments will receive motor fuel, tires, and tubes for carrying out the transportation plans of the transportation enterprises under the administration of the various Länder, i.e., people-owned short-haul transportation enterprises and ATG (General Transportation Companies), and for all intraplant transportation (not including the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry, the Ministry of Postal Affairs and Telecommunications, the Directorates General for the Reichsbahn and for Water Transport, SAG, and ZVO).

All other authorized consumers will receive allocations for their stationary requirements, and for their requirements of liquid fuel, tires, and tubes for trucks and passenger cars, from the quotas of the Land Governments.

9. The production of printed matter for propaganda purposes will be planned for all parties and organizations by the Office of Information via the Land Boards (Landesvorstände) and Central Boards (Zentralvorstände). Allocations will be issued from the quota of the claimant agency "ZVO."

Materials required for printed forms under the central printed-forms system (see Ministerialblatt /Ministerial Gazette/, No 6, 22 February 1951) will not be planned; such materials will be issued to consumers, without allocation certificates, by the proper key publishing enterprises (Leitverlage), on the basis of allocation from the Ministry of Light Industry.

10. The planning and allocation of materials required for carrying out the Plan for Investment Projects, General Repairs, Maintenance, and Licensed Operations [minor projects?] will proceed as follows:

a. Building operations (installation materials, not including materials for electrical installations)

The GDR Ministry of Reconstruction will plan quotas of all materials required to carry out building operations within the scope of the Plan for Investment Projects, General Repairs, Maintenance, and Licensed Operations.

As the claimant agency, this ministry will receive such materials for distribution but will not issue allocations for building operations of the GAG or for building operations carried out for and by the Directorates General of the Reichsbahn and of Water Transport.

Material for carrying out building operations will be issued by the ministry to enterprises engaged in building activities, on the basis of building contracts.

Materials for auxiliary building operations for the mining industry will be planned and allocated by the claimant agencies responsible for the mining operations.

Materials for building operations carried out directly by enterprises of the centrally administered transportation system (Directorates General of the Reichsbahn and of Water Transport) will be planned and allocated by the responsible claimant agency, the Ministry of Transportation.

Building materials for continuous repairs in the centrally administered people-owned industries, expenditures for which are defrayed out of working capital, will be planned by the claimant agencies responsible for the various industries. These claimant agencies will receive the material allocations; if building enterprises are to make the repairs, the claimant agencies must turn over the allocations to them.

These claimant agencies will also plan and allocate building materials when enterprises of the centrally administered people-owned industries use their own workers to do small building jobs.

Building materials for repairs carried out by all other authorized consumers are planned by the Land governments, HA Material Supply, and are allocated, via the Stadtkreise and Landkreise, to the building enterprises charged with carrying out such repairs.

When repairs are carried out by a plant's own workers, the required materials are directly allocated to the plant by the Stadtkreise and Landkreise.

Auxiliary building materials, (such as wooden scaffolding, rigging poles, sheathing, miscellaneous building equipment, and supplies and materials coming under the heading of general expenses) and other equipment for carrying out new construction, general repairs, and licensed operations are planned and allocated by the Ministry of Reconstruction for the centrally administered building trades under the State Secretariat for Building Operations and by the Land governments, HA Material Supply, for building enterprises administered at Land level and for the small building trades enterprises.

Auxiliary building materials for enterprises subordinate to other central claimant agencies which carry out building operations under their own management and supervision are planned and allocated by the claimant agencies responsible for those enterprises.

Building operations also include materials for lightning-arrester equipment; and for passenger elevators and escalators for residential, cultural, and administration buildings; chimney construction; material for foundations for boiler installations (not including external or internal bricking, or walling in of equipment listed in the general index of goods under an assigned number); external and internal bricking of blast furnaces; and material for lining walls, etc.

Not included in building operations are external and internal bricking of boiler installations. (Boiler installations constitute separate and complete projects, and the plants which produce such installations must plan and procure the allocations for bricks and fireproof clay.) Also excluded are materials for constructing permanent ways for railroads, such as rails, ties, splice strips, etc.

Building materials falling under the production requirements of the authorized consumer (for example, cement for the manufacture of items made of reinforced concrete) are planned by said authorized consumer and allocated to him via the responsible claimant agency.

Building operations comprise all construction of buildings through the final finishing, including the installation of plumbing and heating equipment.

Plumbing and heating installations include: for residential and cultural buildings, the complete installation of such equipment, including heating plants, boilers, pumps, motors, etc.; for industrial buildings, the complete heating plants and all plumbing equipment, including boilers, shower installations, etc.

If boilers are used in the production process of an enterprise, or if any part of the boiler capacity is used in this process, the boilers are considered under the heading of equipment and as such must be procured by the authorized investor concerned.

Boiler repairs, and procurement of replacements for heating installations, which fall under the plans for investment projects, maintenance, general repairs, and licensed operations constitute building operations. These operations contribute to the upkeep of finished buildings. Materials for these purposes are drawn against the allocation of the Ministry of Reconstruction.

b. Electrical Installations

The materials and accessories required for electrical installations within the scope of building operations and for installation of equipment, under the plan for investment projects, general repairs, maintenance, and licensed operations, will be planned by the enterprises which construct the equipment to be installed, for example, the VEM (People-Owned Machine-Building Industry), RFT (Radio and Telecommunications Equipment), or the plants which produce electrical installations, according to their own production plans (plan item 51 92 000 - Installations). The materials and accessories for such installations are allocated to these enterprises via the responsible claimant agencies or groups of authorized consumers (i.e., the recipients of the production plan: the Ministry of Machine Building or the Land governments) on the basis of installation contracts concluded by the enterprises. This ruling does not apply in connection with electrical installations for SAG projects. Plants, authorized investors, licensees, etc. who themselves carry out electrical installations and do not employ the services of electrical enterprises for such purpose will be allotted materials directly from the quota of the group of authorized consumers responsible in any given instance for the allocation of equipment, e.g., Section FM [unidentified] of the Stadtkreise and Landkreise.

Materials for building-site equipment for the centrally administered people-owned building industry are planned and allocated by the claimant agency "Ministry of Reconstruction."

The products listed above will be planned and allotted by the claimant agency responsible for supplying the authorized investor.

All other products of the "Electrical Engineering" plan group will be considered material for electrical installations.

The following electrical installations will be considered as falling within the scope of building operations:

In the case of connections to outside overhead lines: The installations from the terminal insulator or from the electrical transformer on the building or on the dead-end tower of the public power network.

In the case of cable connections: The installations from the house terminal box (for power installations under 1,000 volts) or from the cable terminal in the station (for receiver installations supplied with high-voltage current) to the point of outlet (e.g., including wall sockets).

Thus, the State Secretariat for Coal and Power, HV Power, or the power districts are responsible for terminal insulators or transformers on houses or lead-end towers, as well as for house terminal boxes, cable terminals, and metering equipment.

c. Equipment, installation of equipment, and other expenditures (not including material for electrical installations).

All equipment and materials for installation and for other expenditures (initial issue of tools, geological projects, etc.) will be planned by and allocated to plan recipients or agencies authorized to carry out investments, general repairs, maintenance, and licensed operations.

Among others, the following are considered equipment:

Boiler installations for hothouses, drying installations for agricultural enterprises, pumps for well-digging operations, pipelines for use in production, fire-prevention equipment, water pipes; in blast furnace building: pipelines, blast-furnace throat, blast-furnace jacket; varnish and paint for painting after assembly; material for railroad roadbeds (tracks, ties, small ironware). Material for railroad roadbeds for industrial railroad sidings is always planned by the agency authorized to make investments, general repairs, etc., even when it is not a Reichsbahn enterprise.

11. If, during the setting up of the Economic Plan or during the Plan Year 1953, an authorized consumer is transferred from the sphere of responsibility of one claimant agency to that of another, the original claimant agency, in accordance with the planning it has done, must transfer to the new claimant agency all data on material supply planning and also the consumer's shares of the claimant agency's allotments for the whole Plan Year 1953.

12. Material supply planning and distribution of material for trusteeship enterprises is the responsibility of that office which uses the trusteeship enterprises for its task under the plan. If a trusteeship enterprise is transferred to the sphere of responsibility of another claimant agency, the regulation under Section 11 above applies.

The claimant agencies are authorized to set up, on the basis of the index, supplemental lists of consumers for their spheres of competence.
