5. Last year, 1947, Iran supplied some of the crude petroleum. This year it is being procured in Arabia. At present it is being transported in the 10,000-ton tankers "Yung-hung" and "Yung-tee"; two others, the "Yung-ch'ing" and the "Yung-hao," are awaiting completion of repairs. The company has already leased two 15,000-ton American oil tankers with which the supply of crude petroleum can be increased during the latter part of the year.

6. The refinery has two units, each with a daily capacity for refining 1,000 tons of crude oil. Both are at present not operating during the installation of the cracking equipment. It is expected that after September 1948 the plant will be able to refine 20,000 drums of oil per day, the output of gasoline being 8,000 drums.
