The January plan for freight turnover of maritime transport was fulfilled 116.1 percent (tons) by the Far East State Maritime Steamship Line, 111.7 percent (ton-miles), and the passenger transport plan was fulfilled 110.3 percent.

The automobile fleet of the Kray Automobile Administration fulfilled the January transport plan 114.8 percent (quantity of passengers), 123.5 percent (passenger-kilometers), 83.2 percent for freight transport (tons) and 81.2 percent (ton-kilometers).

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The first-quarter 1949 plan for retail trade turnover was fulfilled 30 percent in January, and the first-quarter plan for turnover in public-eating enterprises was fulfilled 29.2 percent. The first-quarter plan for total trade turnover was fulfilled 29.8 percent in January, including 29.2 percent by the Ministry of Trade USSR, 31.9 percent by ORSs and "Prodsumb" (food supply), and 29.6 percent by cooperative organizations.

PRIMORSKIY ENTERPRISES WIN JANUARY AWARDS - Krasnoye Znamya, No 36, 13 Feb 49

The Primorskiy Kray Executive Committee and the Bureau of the Kray Committee VKP(b) reports that the Transferable Red Banner of the two committees has been awarded to the "Sukhbaugol" Trust (director, Litvin; secretary of the Sukhan City Committee VKP(b), Gordiyenko; chairman of the regional committee of the trade union of coal workers, Zhukov) which took first place in the January competition among coal enterprises of the Kray. The trust fulfilled the January plan for coal mining 112.4 percent, for mine preparatory work 111.2 percent, and 104 percent for productivity of labor. The Transferable Red Banner was allowed to remain with the "Sikhali" Combine (director, Slobtsov; chairman of the mine-plant committee, Ivanyuta; secretary of the Party organization, Povitukhin) since it fulfilled the January ore mining plan 103.3 percent and the gross-production plan 101.2 percent.

The Red Banner was allowed to remain with the Nakhodka Construction Administration (chief, Rakocheyev; secretary of the Party organization, Pavlichenko; chairman of the shop committee, Shumilin) which fulfilled the January construction plan 103 percent and decreased construction costs 3.1 percent.

The Cement Plant imeni Stalin (director, Ferens; secretary of the Party bureau, Bayenko; chairman of the plant committee, Yatsenko) took first place in the January competition among construction materials enterprises in the Kray and was awarded the Red Banner. The plant fulfilled the plan for cement output 107 percent and the plan for transport of cement 114.4 percent.

The Vladivostok Commercial Port (chief, Kotov; secretary of the Party bureau, Danilyak; chairman of the port committee, Kuznetsov) took first place in the competition among transport enterprises of the Kray and was awarded the Red Banner. The port fulfilled the January plan for loading and unloading 120.5 percent in tons and 130.6 percent in ton-operations, and 150.8 percent for handling freight by machines.

The Shkotovskiy Rayon Communications Office (chief, Kretov; chairman of the workers' committee, Andreyenko) was awarded the Red Banner for fulfilling the January plan for income 120.5 percent and the plan for increasing the number of radio centers 422 percent.

The Zarubino Fish Combine (acting director, Kuyrin; secretary of the Party organization, Ivanov; chairman of the plant committee, Popenko) fulfilled the January plan for catching fish 131 percent and was awarded the Red Banner.
