COMMUNISTS ALLOW SUBSTITUTE PRODUCTS FOR TAX PAYMENTS

The Financial Administration and Economics Commission of the North China Feople's Government has ruled that in order to increase the production of cotton and planuts, which is one of the chief goals of this year's farm production program, cottom, cottonseed oil, and peanuts may be accepted in place of grain for taxes. One catty $\sqrt{1.3}$ pounds/ of cotton is to count as 8 cattles of rice, one catty of peanuts as 5 cattles of rice, and one catty of cottonseed oil as 4 cattles of rice. When the real market price of these products exceeds these figures, the Trading Company will purchase the goods at the market price.
