WARSAW GETS 366 BILLION ZLOTYS FOR IMPROVEMENTS

CARTWAY TO BECOME LARGE INDUSTRIAL CENTER -- *Zycie Warszawy*, No 250, 11 Sep 49

According to the Six-Year Plan, Warsaw will become a large industrial center. The investment outlay for Warsaw and its suburban areas amounts to 366 billion zlotys, which is approximately 9.4 of the investment outlay for the entire nation. The investment credit will be divided as follows: for development of industry, 105 billion zlotys; for housing construction, 72 billion zlotys; for cultural and social projects, 54.7 billion zlotys; and for municipal transportation and public buildings, 38 billion zlotys.

Warsaw's area, which at present is 142 square kilometers, will be increased to 400 square kilometers. The population will increase from 650,000 to one million.

WORKS TO BE A LARGE INDUSTRIAL AREA -- *Rzeczpospolita*, No 249, 10 Sep 49

Within the next 6 years, the Warsaw suburb of Mokotow will contain two large industrial areas, one at Sluzewiec, the other at Sielce.

The Sluzewiec area, measuring 200 hectares, will contain supply industries, such as plant nurseries, warehouses, refrigeration and processing plants, the "Paged" lumberyards, etc. The only industrial factory, in the strict sense, will be a tool factory employing 2,000 workers and, later, a cigarette factory. Warehouses of the Central Administration of the Coal Industry and a central heating plant will be included later in this area.

The Sielce area will comprise the section between Czerniakowska, Chelmska, and Podchorazych streets. It will contain large government garages, the building of the Central Office of School Supplies, the newsreel and short-feature-film studios. The latter are already under construction.
