REPORTS JUNE CURRENCY FLUCTUATIONS

CURRENCY IN CIRCULATION DECREASES -- Taegliche Rundschau, No 147, 27 Jun 50

The currency in circulation in the German Democratic Republic decreased 124 million Deutsche marks during the second 10-day period of June 1950, dropping to 2,933,000 Deutsche marks, and falling below the 3-billion mark for the first time. The German Notenbank's 20 June statement shows the following:
