CHINA TRADES TUNG OIL, ERISTIES FOR CZECH AMMUNITION

London, 25 Jul (AP) ... The <u>News Chronicle</u> reported today that Britain is aiding the Chinese Communists to secure munitions by buying large quantities of Chinese goods from Czechoslovakia. The latter barters munitions with Communist China in exchange for tung oil and hog bristles and then sells these products to Britain at 100-percent profit. The News Chronicle goes on to say that the British Ministry of Commerce has recently concluded a secret agreement with Czechoslovakia for the purchase of 3,200,000 US dollars' worth of Chinese products.
