CHINESE COMMUNIST UNDERGROUND WORKERS IN HONG KONG AND MACAO TO USE TERRORIST METHODS

Taihoku, 26 June -- The KMT Defense Ministry has reported that Chinese Communist underground workers in Hong Kong and Macao assembled in Swatow early in June 1951 to discuss the progress of activities in these locations. The meeting was said to have concluded with the decision that terrorism should be employed in order to counter anti-Communist activities in both Hong Kong and Macao.
