POLISH TRACTOR PRODUCTION ABOVE QUOTA;
NEW TOLL LINES ESTABLISHED IN WARSAW

200 TRACTORS ABOVE QUOTA -- Warsaw, Folks-Sztyme, 2 Apr 53

On 31 March 1953, the workers' collective of the "Ursus" machine-shop plants agreed to exceed its daily, 10-day, and monthly production quotas. As a result of this agreement, the "Ursus" workers' collective intends to produce 200 tractors above quota during this year. To guarantee the completion of the work in the assembly division, the collectives have promised to fulfill the yearly production of tractor parts in the machine-shop division one month before the deadline. The "Ursus" workers' collective is determined to exceed the April quota by 25 tractors.

To supply the "Ursus" machine-shop plants with more coal which is needed for its increased tractor production, the workers' collective of the "Mieshko" coal mines agreed to meet its yearly production quota by 24 December 1953, and from that date until the end of the year, it pledged to produce 7,900 tons of coal above the quota.

DIRECT SUBURBAN TELEPHONE CALLS TO BE POSSIBLE FROM WARSAW -- Warsaw, Folks-Sztyme, 2 Apr 53

As a result of the recently constructed automatic telephone exchange in Warsaw, which is to become operative shortly, Warsaw toll-line service will be greatly improved this year. To date, telephone calls from Warsaw to Wlochy, Ursus, Grodzisk, Otwock, and other cities have to be placed with the toll-line operator, and it frequently takes several hours before calls can get through.

During 1953, special [exchange] numbers will be assigned to telephones located in the suburban areas of Warsaw. Thus, by dialing 52, a telephone subscriber will be able to get a direct connection with Wlochy, Ursus, and Piastow; by dialing 54 he will get Otwock and Radosc; by dialing 56, he will get Piasieczno; and by dialing 58, he will reach Pruzkow, Grodzisk, Milanowek, and Podkowa Lesna.

The main telephone exchange will announce the date on which these special numbers will become operative.
