1949 PRODUCTION DATA FOR CERTAIN FACTORIES
IN TIENTSIN AND NUNKIANG PROVINCE

Summary: This report gives information from the appendix of Kung-ch'ang Kuan-li Min-chu-hua (Democratization of Factory Management). It includes the production data and names of several factories located in Tientsin, and in Nunkiang Province in North-east China in 1949.

Tientsin Factories Increase Production

The Chung-hua Match Factory (Chung-hua Huo-ch'ang, 中華火廠) produced 2,500 boxes of matches during June 1949, exceeding its planned output.

The Railway Parts Plant of the Ministry of Railways (T'ieh-tao-pu Kang-t'ieh P'ei-chian-ch'ang, 鐵道部鋼鐵配件廠) completed the production of 470,000 spikes and 175,000 tie plates during May 1949, exceeding or completing its planned monthly output of 450,000 spikes and 175,000 tie plates.

Twenty-one workers in the forging department of the Automobile Parts Factory (Chi-sha Chih-p'ei-ch'ang, 汽車裝配廠) increased the daily output of forged materials from eight bundles to ten bundles, and again to 12 bundles, and finally to 20 bundles during May 1949. They were planning to increase the output figure by another three bundles in June.

The workers in the piston department of the same plant produced a total of 71 pistons during May 1949. It was 2.7 times the highest figure attained before liberation.

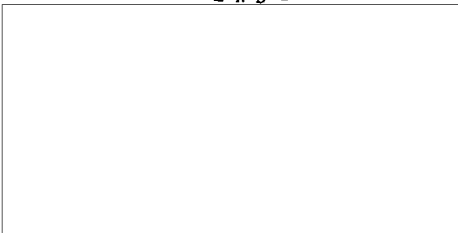
The Tung-ya Tobacco Company (Tung-ya Yen-ts'ao Kung-ssu, 東亞烟草公司) increased its daily cigarette output from 180 trays to 190 trays during June 1949, and was hoping to increase the output to 250 trays in July.

Nunkiang Province's Industrial Control Bureau Reviews Progress

The Nunkiang Province's Industrial Control Bureau has called a meeting of factory chiefs and members of factory management committees of all the factories under its jurisdiction to review the progress of democratization of factory management. It was reported at the meeting that the following achievements have already been made in the democratization of factory management since it was initiated in December 1948:

1. The Nen-chiang Weaving Factory (Nen-chiang Fang-chih-ch'ang, 嫩江綢緞廠) and the Hsin-hua Weaving Factory (Hsin-hua Fang-chih-ch'ang, 新華綢緞廠) have increased their production through competitive production movement.
2. The Nen-chiang Ironworks (Nen-chiang T'ieh-kung-ch'ang, 嫩江鐵工廠) is making necessary readjustments to its overly democratized form of factory management which was hampering rather than helping to increase production.
3. The Li-min Weaving Factory (Li-min Fang-chih-ch'ang, 利民綢緞廠) has initiated the education of workers on the subject of democratization of factory management.
