USSR TERRITORIAL-ADMINISTRATIVE CHANGES, (TWO)

[Comment: The following territorial-administrative changes were reported in the January-April 1954 Soviet press. The dates of the ukases establishing the changes are given when available.

The ukases are arranged alphabetically by republic, and are listed chronologically by source dates thereunder.

Numbers in parentheses refer to appended sources.]

AZERBAIDZHAN SSR

By a 9 March 1954 decree the Supreme Soviet Azerbaydzhan SSR confirmed the 28 January 1954 ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Azerbaydzhan SSR, abolishing Samukhskiy Rayon.(1)

By a 4 February 1954 ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Azerbaydzhan SSR, the city of Mingechaur, Khaldanskiy Rayon, is designated a city of republic subordination.(2)

BELORUSSIAN SSR

The Presidium, Supreme Soviet USSR, by an 8 January 1954 ukase confirmed the proposal of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Belorussian SSR, to abolish the following oblasts:

Baranovichskaya Oblast, its territory being transferred as follows -- Bytenskiy, Gorodishchenskiy, Lyakhovichskiy, and Novomyshskiy rayons and the city of Baranovichi to Brestskaya Oblast; Dyatlovskiy, Kozlovshchinskiy, Kor-elichskiy, Lyubchanskiy, Mirskiy, Novogrudskiy, and Slonimskiy rayons to Grod-nenskaya Oblast; Kletskiy, Nesvizhskiy, and Stolbtsovskiy rayons to Minskaya Oblast; and Ivenetskiy Rayon to Molodechnenskaya Oblast.

Bobruyskaya Oblast, its territory being transferred as follows -- Oktyabr'skiy and Parichskiy rayons to Gomel'skaya Oblast; Gluskiy, Gresskiy, Kopyl'skiy, Krasnoslobodskiy, Lyuban'skiy, Slutskiy, Starobinskiy, and Starodorozhskiy rayons and the city of Slutsk to Minskaya Oblast; and Bobruyskiy, Kirovskiy, Klichevskiy, and Osipovichskiy rayons and the city of Bobruysk to Mogilevskaya Oblast.

Polotskaya Oblast, its territory being transferred as follows -- Vetrinskiy, Drissenskiy, Osveyskiy, Polotskiy, Rossonskiy, and Ushachskiy rayons and the city of Polotsk to Vitebskaya Oblast; and Braslavskiy, Vidzovskiy, Glubokskiy, Disnenskiy, Dokshitskiy, Dumilovichskiy, Miorskiy, Plisskiy, and Sharkovshchinskiy rayons to Molodechnenskaya Oblast.

Pinskaya Oblast, its territory being transferred to Brestskaya Oblast.

Poleskaya Oblast, its territory being transferred to Gomel'skaya Oblast.

By an 8 January 1954 ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Belorussian SSR, Iv'yevskiy Rayon of Molodechnenskaya Oblast and Ruzhanskiy Rayon of Brestskaya Oblast are transferred to Grodnenskaya Oblast.(3)

GEORGIAN SSR

By ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Georgian SSR, the following populated points are designated workers' settlements:

Populated point at the construction site of Ladzhanurskaya Hydroelectric Power Station near Ladzhan Village, Tsagerskiy Rayon, being named LadzhanurGES Tsentral'nyy Workers' Settlement.

Populated point at the construction site of Ladzhanurskaya Hydroelectric Power Station near Adzhar Village, being named LadzhanurGES Workers' Settlement.

Populated point at the construction site of Gumatskaya Hydroelectric Power Station between Rioni and Dzhimastaro villages, Kutaiskiy Rayon, being named GumatiGES Workers' Settlement.

Populated point at the construction site of Tkibul'skaya Hydroelectric Power Station near Dzevri Village and in the vicinity of Tsintskil, Terzhol'skiy Rayon, being named TkibulGES Workers' Settlement.

Populated point at the construction site of Sionskiy Reservoir near Sioni Village, Tianetskiy Rayon, being named Sionstroy Workers' Settlement.

By these same ukase the populated point at the construction site of Ladzhanurskaya Hydroelectric Power Station near Chkhuteli Village, Tsagerskiy Rayon, is included in Tsageri Settlement.

By ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Georgian SSR, the settlement (poseleniye) of the construction section of Gardabanskiy Rayon is combined with a group of villages and named Gamardzhveba Village. Gamardzhveba Village is separated from Agtaglinskiy Village Soviet, and Gamardzhvebskiy Village Soviet is formed.

By ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Georgian SSR, populated point at Anaseul'skiy Scientific Research Institute and Ekadia Village are separated from Makvanetskiy Village Soviet, Makharadzevskiy Rayon, and made administratively subordinate to Makharadze City Soviet.(4)

By a 22 January 1954 ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Latvian SSR, populated point of Sedas, Valkskiy Rayon, is designated a workers' settlement.

RSFSR

By ukases of 6 January 1954 the Presidium, Supreme Soviet USSR, confirmed the proposal of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet RSFSR, on the formation of the following oblasts:

Balashovskaya Oblast, with its center in the city of Balashov, and consisting of the cities of Balashov and Rtishchevo of Saratovskaya Oblast and Borisoglebsk of Voronezhskaya Oblast and the following rayons -- Arkadakskiy, Balashovskiy, Kazachkinskiy, Kistendeyanskiy, Krasavskiy, Makarovskiy, Novo-Pokrovskiy, Rodnichkovskiy, Romanovskiy, Rtishchevskiy, Saitykovskiy, Samoylovskiy, and Turkovskiy rayons of Saratovskaya Oblast; Budarinskiy, Vyazovskiy, Dobrinskiy, Yelanskiy, Kikvidzenskiy, Lemeshekinskiy, Macheshanskiy, Nekhayevskiy, Novo-Nikolayevskiy, Rudnyanskiy, Uryupinskiy, and Khoperskiy rayons of Stalingradskaya Oblast; Aleshkovskiy, Baychurovskiy, Verkhne-Karachanskiy, Gribanovskiy, Kozlovskiy, Novokhoperskiy, Peskovskiy, Povorinskiy, Polyanskiy, and Ternovskiy rayons of Voronezhskaya Oblast; and Muchkapskiy and Shapkinskiy rayons of Tambovskaya Oblast.

Belgorodskaya Oblast, with its center in the city of Belgorod, and consisting of the cities of Belgorod and Staryy Oskol of Kurskaya Oblast and the following rayons -- Belgorodskiy, Belenikhinskiy, Bobrovo-Dvorskiy, Bol'she-Troitskiy, Borisovskiy, Valuyskiy, Veliko-Mikhaylovskiy, Volokonovskiy, Grayvoronskiy, Ivnyanskiy, Korochanskiy, Krasnoyarsuzhskiy, Mikoyanovskiy, Novo-Oskol'skiy, Prokhorovskiy, Rakityanskiy, Sazhenskiy, Skorodnyanskiy, Staro-Oskol'skiy, Tomarovskiy, Urazovskiy, Chernyanskiy and Shebekinskiy rayons of Kurskaya Oblast; and Alekseyevskiy, Budennovskiy, Veydelevskiy, Ladomirovskiy, Nikitovskiy, Roven'skiy, Ukolovskiy and Shatalovskiy rayons of Voronezhskaya Oblast.

Kamenskaya Oblast, with its center in the city of Kamensk-Shakhtinskiy, and consisting of the cities of Kamensk-Shakhtinskiy, Shakhty, Krasnyy Sulin, Millerovo, and Novoshakhtinsk and the following rayons -- Alekseyevo-Lozovskiy, Bazkovskiy, Belokalitvenskiy, Bokovskiy, Verkhnedonskoy, Veshenskiy, Voloshinskiy, Glubokinskiy, Zverevskiy, Kamenskiy, Kasharskiy, Kiyevskiy, Kolushkinskiy, Konstantinovskiy, Krasnogvardeyskiy, Krivorozhskiy, Litvinovskiy, Mal'chevskiy, Migulinskiy, Milyutinskiy, Morozovskiy, Nikolayevskiy, Oblivskiy, Oktyabr'skiy, Razdorskiy, Selivanovskiy, Skosyrskiy, Tarasovskiy, Tatsinskiy, Tsimlyanskiy, Chernyshevskiy and Chertkovskiy rayons of Rostovskaya Oblast; and Bogucharskiy, Kantemirovskiy, Mikhaylovskiy, Pisarevskiy and Radchenskiy rayons of Voronezhskaya Oblast; Nizhne-Chirskiy, Perelazovskiy, Serafinovichskiy, and Chernyshkovskiy Rayons of Stalingradskaya Oblast.

Lipetskaya Oblast, with its center in the city of Lipetsk, and consisting of the cities of Lipetsk of Voronezhskaya Oblast and Yelets of Orlovskaya Oblast and the following rayons -- Borinskiy, Vodop'yanovskiy, Grachevskiy, Gryazinskiy, Dmitryashevskiy, Dobrinskiy, Lipetskiy, Molotovskiy, Talitskiy, Usmanskiy, Khvorostyanskiy and Khlevenskiy rayons of Voronezhskaya Oblast; Volynskiy, Dolgorukovskiy, Yeletskiy, Zadonskiy, Izmalkovskiy, Krasninskiy, Stanovlyanskiy, Chernavskiy and Chibisovskiy rayons of Orlovskaya Oblast; Berezovskiy, Voskresenskiy, Dankovskiy, Dobrovskiy, Kolybel'skiy, Lebedyanskiy, Lev-Tolstovskiy, Troyekurovskiy, Trubetchinskiy and Chaplyginskiy rayons of Ryazanskaya Oblast; and Bol'she-Polyanskiy, Volovskiy and Terbunskiy rayons of Kurskaya Oblast.

By a 7 January 1954 ukase the Presidium, Supreme Soviet USSR, confirmed the proposal of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet RSFSR, on the formation of Arzamasskaya Oblast, with its center in the city of Arzamas, and consisting of the cities of Arzamas, Vyksu, and Kulebaki and the following rayons of Gor'kovskaya Oblast: Ardatovskiy, Arzamasskiy, Bol'she-Boldinskiy, Bol'she-Mares'yevskiy, Buturlinskiy, Vadskiy, Voznesenskiy, Vyksunskiy, Gaginskiy, Diveyevskiy, Kzylchikovskiy, Knyagininskiy, Kulebaskiy, Kurmyshskiy, Lukoyanovskiy, Mordovshchikovskiy, Mukhtolovskiy, Narukovskiy, Pervomayskiy, Perevozskiy, Petryakinskiy, Pil'nenskiy, Pochinkovskiy, Razinskiy, Salganskiy, Sergachskiy, Sechenovskiy, Smirnovskiy, Spasskiy, Talyzinskiy, Chernukhinskiy and Shatkovskiy.

By ukases of 22 December 1953 the Presidium, Supreme Soviet RSFSR, decreed the following territorial-administrative changes:

Ves'yegonsk Workers' Settlement, Ves'yegonskiy Rayon, Kalininskaya Oblast, is designated a city of rayon subordination.

The city of Pushkino, Pushkinskiy Rayon, Moskovskaya Oblast, is designated a city of oblast subordination.

The center of Buynakskiy Rayon, Dagestanskaya ASSR, is transferred from Nizhneye Kazanishche Village (seleniye) to Buynaksk City.

The following are designated workers' settlements -- populated point of Goreloye of the suburban zone (prigorodnoy zony) of Gubakha (city), Molotovskaya Oblast, being named Shumikhinskiy; populated point of Kapetnya, Ukhtomskiy Rayon, Moskovskaya Oblast; and populated point of Maklakovo, Yeniseyskiy Rayon, Krasnoyarskiy Kray.(5)

By a 14 January 1954 ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet RSFSR, Step-anovskiy Village Soviet of Yelovskiy Rayon, Molotovskaya Oblast, is transferred to Votkinskiy Rayon, Udmurtskaya ASSR.

By 14 and 19 January 1954 ukases of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet RSFSR, the following are designated workers' settlements:

Populated point of Artemgres of the suburban zone of Artem (city), Primorskiy Kray. It is renamed Artemovskiy and made administratively subordinate to Artem City Soviet.

Populated points of Khrustal'nyy and Verkhne-Imanskiy, Tetyukhinskiy Rayon, Primorskiy Kray.(6)

By a 24 February 1954 ukase the Presidium, Supreme Soviet USSR, confirmed the proposal of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet RSFSR, changing the name of Dzauzhikau (city), Severo-Osetinskaya ASSR, to Ordzhonikidze (city).

By a 19 February 1954 ukase the Presidium, Supreme Soviet USSR, confirmed the joint proposal of the Presidiums of the Supreme Soviet of the RSFSR and the Ukrainian SSR on the transfer of Krymskaya Oblast from the RSFSR to the Ukrainian SSR.(7)

By a 7 April 1954 ukase the Presidium, Supreme Soviet USSR, confirmed the proposal of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet RSFSR, to rename Voroponovo Railway Station of the Volga Railway System as Station imeni Maksim Gor'kiy.

By ukases of 25 March 1954 the Presidium, Supreme Soviet RSFSR, transferred the center of Arzamasskiy Rayon, Arzamasskaya Oblast, from the city of Arzamas to Vyvezdnoye Village, and transferred Cheugdinskiy Village Soviet from Verkhne-Bureyskiy Rayon, Khabarovskiy Kray, to Bureyskiy Rayon, Amurskaya Oblast.

Buron, Sadonskiy Rayon, Severo-Osetinskaya ASSR.

By a 3 April ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet RSFSR the following rayons are abolished in Leningradskaya Oblast:

Voznesenskiy Rayon, its territory being transferred to Podporozhskiy Rayon.

Primorskiy Rayon, its territory being transferred to Roshchinskiy Rayon.

Pargolovskiy Rayon, its territory being transferred to Vsevolozhskiy Rayon.(2)

TADZHIK SSR

By ukases of 29 December 1953 the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Tadzhik SSR, designated Kirovabad City-Type Settlement, Kirovabadskiy Rayon, a city of rayon subordination and Gissar Village (kishlak), Gissarskiy Rayon, a city-type settlement.(6)

The Supreme Soviet Tadzhik SSR on 2 March 1954 issued decrees confirming the following ukases of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Tadzhik SSR:

Ukase of 24 September 1953 abolishing Yakamt Village (kishlak) Soviet, Dangarinskiy Rayon, Kulyabskaya Oblast.

Ukase changing the territorial-administrative boundaries between Voroshilovabad and Stakhanovskiy Village (kishlak) Soviets and combining Voroshilovabad and Khushvakht Village (kishlak) Soviets, Kurgan-Tyubinskiy Rayon.

Ukase abolishing Kipchak Village (kishlak) Soviet, Gissarskiy Rayon.

Ukase abolishing Stalinskiy Village (kishlak) Soviet, Kzyl-Mazarskiy Rayon, Kulyabskaya Oblast.

Ukase abolishing Zagara Villag: (kishlak) Soviet, Khovalingskiy Rayon, Kulyabskaya Oblast.

Ukase abolishing Darai nazarak [sic] Village (kishlak) Soviet, Tadzhikabadskiy Rayon, Garmskaya Oblast.

Ukase abolishing Devak Village (kishlak) Soviet, Regarskiy Rayon.

Ukase abolishing Pushtimiona Village (kishlak) Soviet, Shakhrinauskiy Rayon.

Ukase of 30 October 1953 abolishing Putup Village (kishlak) Soviet, Ishkashimskiy Rayon, Gorno-Badakhshanskaya Atonomous Oblast.

Ukase establishing the territorial-administrative boundaries for Ordzhonikidzeabadskiy, Stalinabadskiy, and Dangarinskiy Rayons, Kulyabskaya Oblast.

Ukase of 30 November 1953 establishing boundaries between Kaganovichabadskiy and Molotovabadskiy Rayons.

Ukase changing the territorial-administrative boundaries between Vatan and Dekhkanaryi Village (kishlak) Soviets, Parkharskiy Rayon, Kulyabskaya Oblast.

Ukase on the formation of Kurusay Settlement Soviet in Leninabadskiy Rayon, Leninabadskaya Oblast.

Ukase changing the territorial-administrative boundaries between Chil'gazy and Shakhvak Village (kishlak) Soviets, Isfarinskiy Rayon, Leninabadskaya Oblast.

Ukase forming Gissar Settlement Soviet in Gissarskiy Rayon.

Ukase of 12 January 1954 abolishing Dubeda Village (kishlak) Soviet, Fayzabadskiy Rayon (8)

UKRAINIAN SSR

By ukases of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Ukrainian SSR, the settlement at Mine No 2-Severnaya, Popovski Village Soviet, Krasnodonskiy Rayon, Voroshilovgradskaya Oblast, is designated a city-type settlement and named Severnyy, and settlement at Mine No 5-6, Volodarskiy Settlement Soviet, Sverdlovskiy Rayon, is designated a city-type settlement and named Komsomol'skiy.(9)

By a 7 January 1954 ukase the Presidium, Supreme Soviet USSR, confirmed the proposal of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Ukrainian SSR, on the formation of Cherkasskaya Oblast with its center in the city of Cherkassy, and consisting of the cities of Cherkassy, Uman', and Smela and the following rayons: Babanskiy, Bukskiy, Gorodishchenskiy, Zhashkovskiy, Zvenigorodskiy, Kanevskiy, Katerinopol'skiy, Korsun'-Shevchenkovskiy, Ladyzhinskiy, Lysyanskiy, Man'kovskiy, Mokro-Kaligorskiy, Ol'shanskiy, Rotmistrovskiy, Smelyanskiy, Tal'novskiy, Uman'skiy, Khristinovskiy, Cherkasskiy and Shpolyanskiy rayons from Kiyevskaya Oblast; Gel'myazovskiy, Drabovskiy, Zolotonoshskiy, Irkleyevskiy, Snamkovskiy and Chernobayevskiy rayons from Poltavskaya Oblast; Zlatopol'skiy and Kamenskiy rayons from Kirovogradskaya Oblast; and Monastyrishchenskiy Rayon from Vinnitskaya Oblast.

By a 6 January 1954 ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Ukrainian SSR, Zgurovskiy and Yagotinskiy rayons are transferred from Poltavskaya Oblast to Kiyevskaya Oblast.(10)

By a 16 January 1954 ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Ukrainian SSR, the city of Proskurov is renamed Khmel'nitskiy and Kamenets-Podol'skaya Oblast is renamed Khmel'nitskaya Oblast in honor of the 300th anniversary of the reunification of the Ukraine and Russia and in memory of the service to the Ukrainian and Russian peoples by military leader Bogdan Khmel'nitskiy.(11)

By a 17 February 1954 ukases of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Ukrainian SSR, Gayvoronskiy, Golovanevskiy, Ol'shanskiy and Ul'yanovskiy rayons are transferred from Odesskaya Oblast to Kirovogradskaya Oblast, and the city of Pervomaysk and Bol'she-Vradiyevskiy, Domanevskiy, Krivoozerskiy, Mostovskiy, and Pervomayskiy rayons are transferred from Odesskaya Oblast to Nikolayevskaya Oblast.(12)

By a 15 February 1954 ukase the Presidium, Supreme Soviet USSR, confirmed the proposal of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Ukrainian SSR, on the abolition of Izmail'skaya Oblast and the transfer of its territory to Odesskaya Oblast.

By a 12 February 1954 ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Ukrainian SSR, Chigirinskiy Rayon, Kirovogradskaya Oblast, is transferred to Cherkasskaya Oblast.(7)

By a 26 March 1954 ukase the Presidium, Supreme Soviet USSR, confirmed the proposal of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Ukrainian SSR, changing the name of Proskurov Railway Station of the Southwestern Railway System to Khmel'nitskaya Station.(13)

By ukases of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Ukrainian SSR, Chigirin City-Type Settlement, Chigirinskiy Rayon, Cherkasskaya Oblast, has been designated a city of rayon subordination, and the settlement of Mine No 30/35 of Almazovskiy Settlement Soviet, Roven'kovskiy Rayon, Voroshilovgradskaya Oblast is designated a city-type settlement and named Mikhaylovka. Vengerovka, Karshino, and Prishchepino of Almazovskiy Settlement Soviet are included within the boundaries of Mikhaylovka City-Type Settlement.(14)

By a 26 December 1953 ukase of the Presidium, Supreme Soviet Uzbek SSR, populated point of Shabbaz, Shabbazskiy Rayon, Kara-Kalpakskaya ASSR, is designated a city-type settlement.(6)
