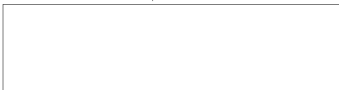

1. Comment. The shipments for 5 to 22 August are not included. 25X1

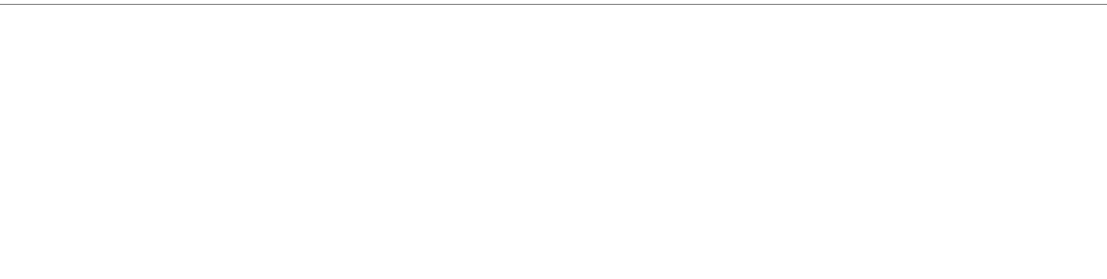
2. Comment. The list indicates the first increase since June 1952 of incoming supply. A total of 330 carloads arrived and of these, 110 were loaded with flour and 50 with tobacco and tobacco products.

3. Comment. The volume of outgoing shipments in September, a total of 182 carloads, including about 28 with flour and 33 with tobacco, was considerably lower than the volume of incoming shipments in that month. During the preceding months, incoming and outgoing shipments were about equal. 25X1

4. Comment. it is believed that the observation of 139 incoming shipments in August is complete. 25X1

5. Comment. a total of 357 carloads arrived in September 1952. 25X1

6. Comment. The number of 124 carloads of outgoing shipments is believed to be complete.
