- On 19 December 1952, a train of 1 coach, 1 boxcar and 23 flatcars with 28 M-13 rocket launchers [Redacted] was observed at the Oranienburg railroad station. The train came from Stendal and was bound for Brest Litovsk.<sup>1</sup>

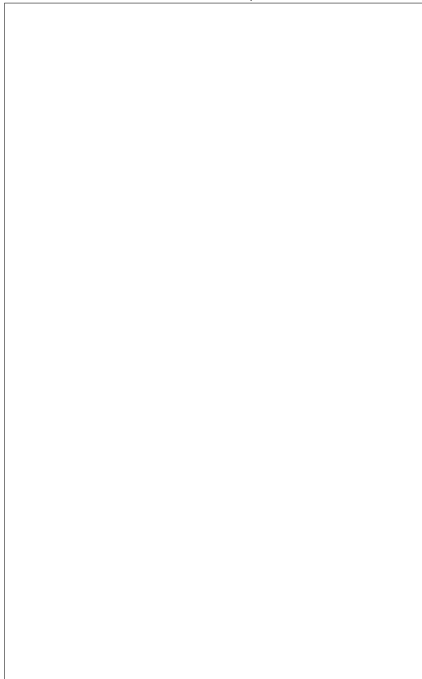

1. Comment.

the LXXIX Mtz Rifle Corps in Stendal had received 28 M-31 rocket launchers on 5 December 1952. The information in paragraph 1 of the present report definitely indicates that the M-13 rocket launchers of the regiment mentioned in the reference report were replaced by rocket launchers of the M-31 type. It is noteworthy that the shipment from Stendal to Brest-Litovsk included 28 rocket launchers only, contrarily to the assumption that 32 or 36 rocket launchers belong to the equipment of a rocket launcher regiment of a rifle corps. It is possible, however, that several M-31 rocket launchers had previously been exchanged.
