- 2. Dinasit tiles are of importance because they are used in the construction of blast furnaces.
- 3. Most of the Dinasit tiles produced at Horni Briza during the first quarter of 1952 were for Kuncice near Moravska Ostrava, Kladno, and the Skoda Works. 1 As much as 90% of the Dinasit tiles exported went to Poland.
