- The Komarno shipyards have an order for the construction for the USSR of 32 passenger ships for lake and river traffic. Specifications call for dimensions of 12 meters in width and 70 meters in length, and for 2,000 horsepower.
- 2. Two of these ships, the RUSSIA and the CAUCASE, were delivered on 15 September 1952. The instruments on these ships are in the Russian language. The CAUCASE is a luxury ship.
- 3. 16 tugboats for the USSR have also been ordered. Specifications and delivery dates for these are not known.
