As of 11 November 20 tons of steel castings for SAG AMO and 4,000 tons of iron slabs (Brammen) for the Ernst-Thaelmann Werk still had to be assigned to a plant under the Ministry of Mining and Smelting. The Administration for Soviet Property in Germany had assigned Riessa and Maxhuette the production of the iron slabs, but neither of these factories produces them; only Stahl- und Walzwerk Brandenburg includes iron slabs in its production program. The Ministry of Mining and Smelting was also forced to request the Administration to withdraw its demands for gray iron castings from VEB Kala, Senftenberg, and Eisengleiserei Mittweida, since neither of the plants is administered by the Ministry.
