SOURCE:

1. An informant in Craiova reported to source that during the maneuvers of September 1952 the Rumanian Army had as its problem: "Defense against an imperialist attack coming through the southeast from Yugoslavia."
2. During maneuvers Communist military authorities assisted by the police, made every effort to prevent infiltration of enemy agents into the maneuver area. Both the participating troops and the local civilian population were carefully watched.
3. Some Yugoslav adherents of the Cominform participated as soldiers in the maneuvers.
