25X1 [redacted] Comment. A small number of motor vehicles was shipped from the U.S.S.R. to East Germany after early January 1953. It has not yet been determined if these shipments were connected with the motor vehicle exchange program.

25X1 [redacted] Comment. Raw material deliveries to the Foundry Combine East near Puerstenberg/Oder.

25X1 [redacted] Comment. Deliveries by East German hydrogenation plants to the U.S.S.R. and returning empty tank cars.

25X1 [redacted] Comment. The possibility that the shipment record numbering system was changed in January 1953 was reported previously. [redacted] The present report supports this assumption.

25X1 [redacted] Comment. Returning standard-gauge wheel sets which had been used on new railroad cars delivered by East German railroad car factories to the U.S.S.R.

25X1 [redacted] Comment. Probably tanks which returned from the U.S.S.R. after being overhauled there. The fact that these tanks were sent to Wuensdorf and Kirchmoeser, the two largest Soviet tank repair shops in East Germany supports this assumption. The 15 tanks dispatched to Frankfurt/Oder will probably be forwarded from there to units in East Germany. The ratio of the number of flatcars to that of the tanks shipped indicates that some RRym-type flatcars, which can carry two tanks, were also used.
